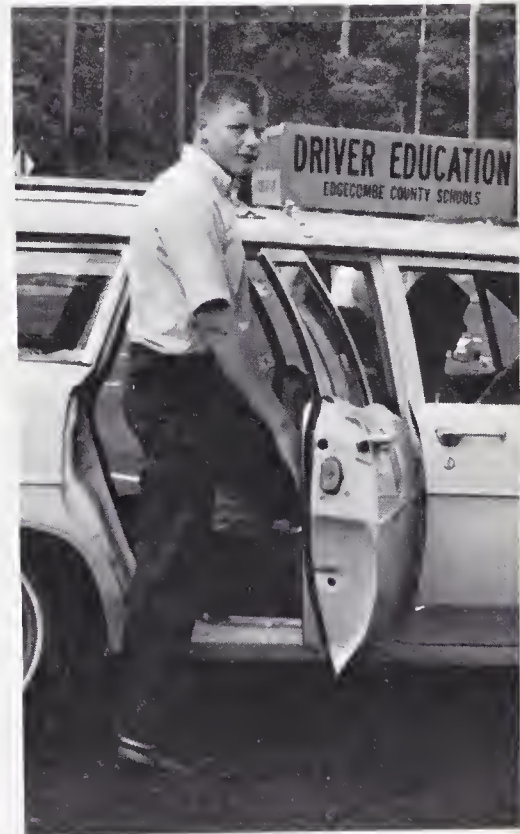
# Driver Education

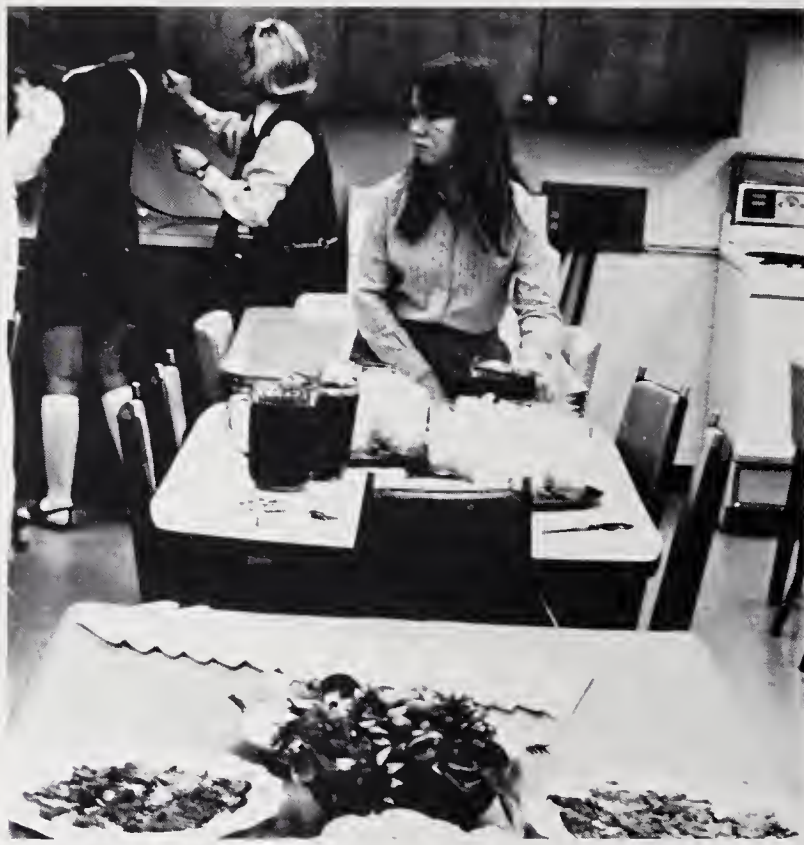

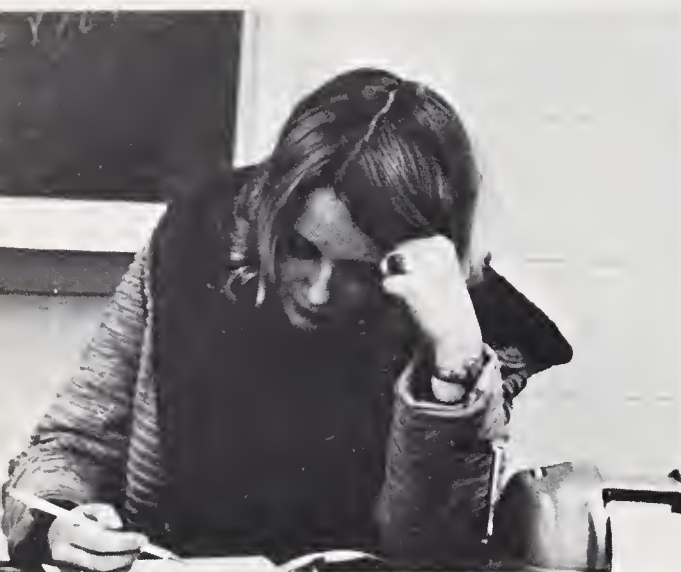
## Beta Club

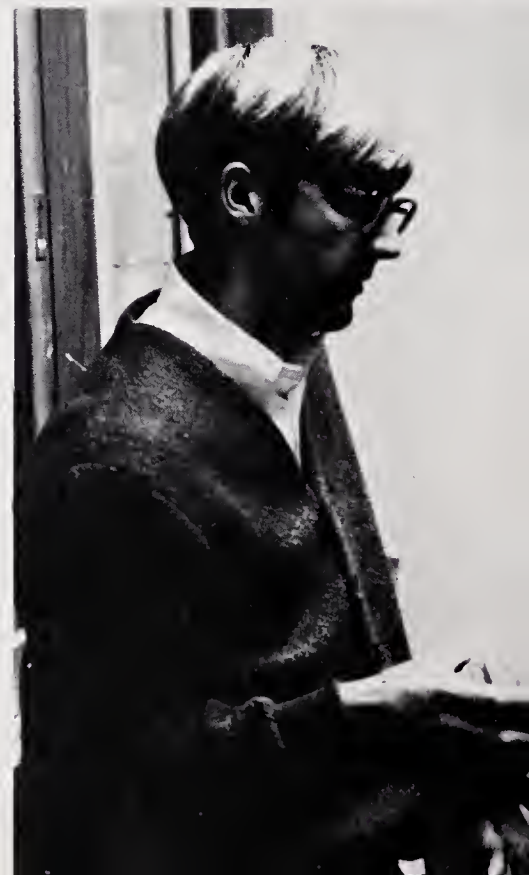


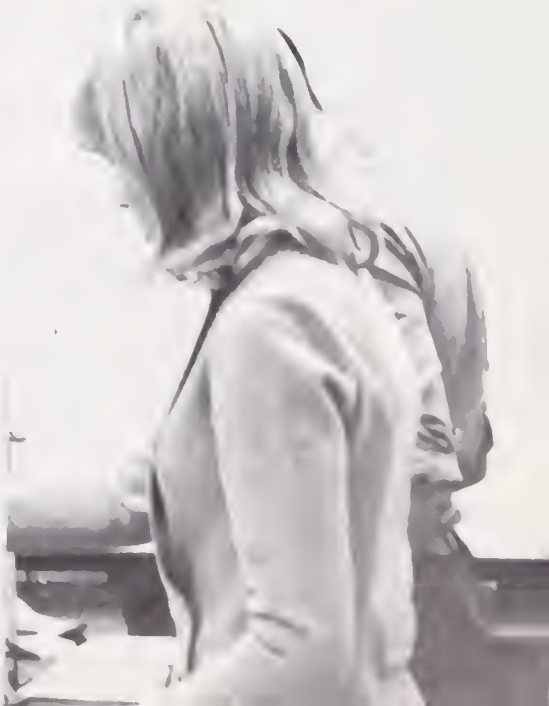


# Annual Staff

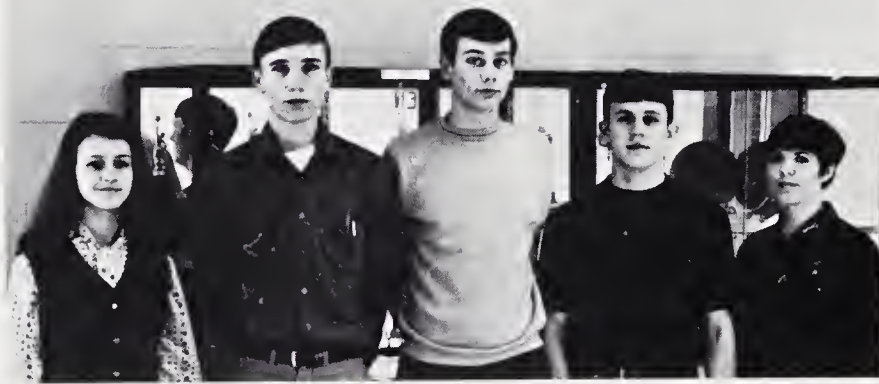
Before a person can obtain a bus license, he must take an eye test, a written test, and a road test.
