THE PRICES in this list are all Net and the goods will be delivered at freight depots or express offices in Detroit, but we **do not pay the charges of transportation.** If seeds are ordered sent by mail, postage must be added to these prices at the rate of 8 cents per pound.

In common with some other seedsmen we have, for the convenience of our customers as well as ourselves, discontinued the use of the terms bushel, peck, quart and pint and now quote all seed listed in our catalogue by weight.

Half pound and over at pound rate. Ten pounds and over at the 100 pound rate. We do not put up half pounds of Beans, Corn or Peas.

To every order for 10 pounds and upwards to the amount of 100 pounds, 50 cents must be added for a new bag, box or barrel in which to ship. If this is not done the quantity ordered will be reduced to cover cost of container.

Please be particular **always** to give your **name and address** when writing us. If you are not located on a railroad, always give your Shipping Point on every order.
