Our price includes delivery on all plants and bulbs. Trees, shrubs and evergreens are priced at the nursery and are subject to a packing charge, if prepared for shipment. ALSO PLEASE NOTE, -we require an additional 5% for shipments west of the Mississippi River.

Customers requiring trees, shrubs, evergreens, vines, fruit trees, or fruit and berry plants, will find it advisable to call at the nursery, and select the material they need, taking it with them, or arranging to have it delivered by truck.

In addition, we maintain a complete Landscape Service, and can undertake any work in that line. Lawns are a specialty, as are shrub and evergreen plantings, hedges, and perennial gardens. A competent designer is available for those who wish plans drawn. Supervision and labor by trained men shortens the time required, and insures success.

We can move large trees, both deciduous and evergreen, in any size to twelve inches on the stump. Rates on request.
