Being better prepared for the Fall Festival this year, we were quite eager to try our hand

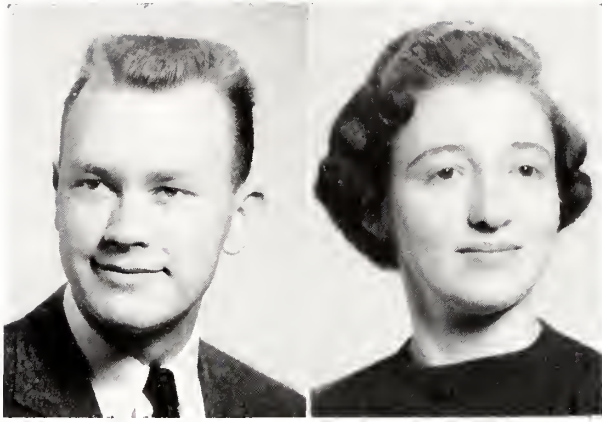
