We believe that nothing could be better than being Juniors, but we are looking forward to our Senior year when we will be "top-notch" at D.H.S.

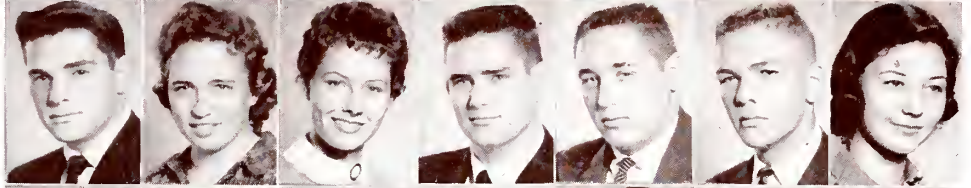

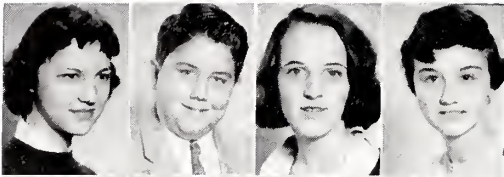
Remembering, sometimes not too fondly, the strains of "Hey, skin!", we sophomores look back over the events of our first year at D.H.S.

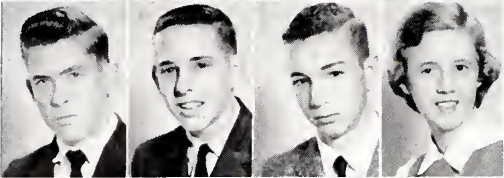
full support as did our skilled athletic teams. Enthusiastically the sophomores participated and showed much interest in the Junior Talent Show as well as other various school activities.
