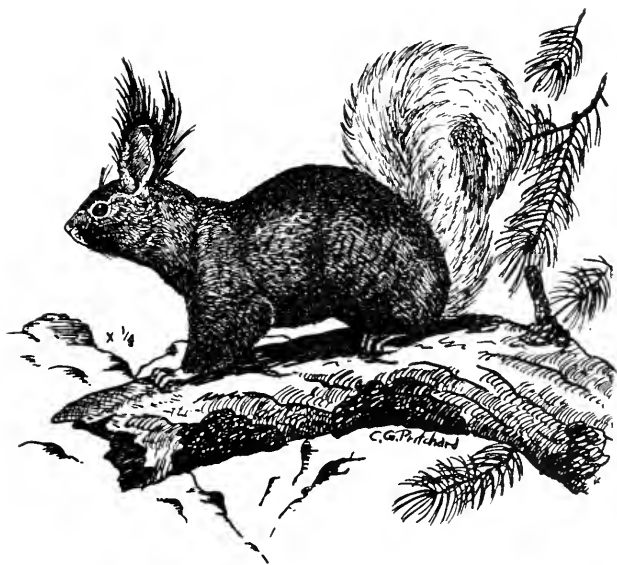

Names of Species of North American Mammals North of Mexico

In 1957 it was thought that an impetus would be given to the study of mammals by the issuance of a list of the "*Vernacular Names for North American Mammals North of Mexico*" (see Univ. Kansas Mus. Nat. Hist. Misc. Pub., 14:1-16, June 19, 1957, by E. R. Hall, S. Anderson, J. K. Jones, Jr., and R. L. Packard).

Requests for copies of that 1957 list exhausted the supply much sooner than was expected. That circumstance and several suggestions that the material be duplicated are responsible for the following pages. In the eight years that have elapsed since the original list was published, advances in zoological knowledge require the addition of some new names and deletion of others. Consequently the list that follows has been revised so as to bring it up to date.

The scientific names are correct according to the Law of Priority (with beginning date of January 1, 1758) except that opinions of the International Commission on Zoological Nomenclature have been followed as to works published after 1757 that are to be ignored because they are not consistently binomial.

As was the case in the earlier (1957) list, a given vernacular name is applied to a species and is considered appropriate for all subspecies of that species. Examples that illustrate the reasons for the changes that have been made in vernacular names are the following: Gaillard's Jack Rabbit (*Lepus gaillardi*) has been shown to be only a subspecies of the more southern and longer-known White-sided Jack Rabbit (*Lepus callotis*) of Mexico and so the name White-sided Jack Rabbit replaces the name Gaillard's Jack Rabbit of the 1957 list. The Western Pocket Gopher (*Thomomys mazama*) formerly thought to be only a subspecies of the Northern Pocket Gopher (*Thomomys talpoides*) has been shown (along with some other subspecies) to be a species distinct from the Northern Pocket Gopher and so the name Western Pocket Gopher is an addition to the list. Huey's Kangaroo Rat (*Dipodomys cascus*), another addition, is a species named since the 1957 list was published.

An asterisk (*) denotes non-native species from other continents that have become established in North America in the past few hundred years.
