leaves were about 6.3 cm. long and
widest at a tap or 1.5 cm. wide and taper and narrowest
near the base and then narrow to 1.5 cm. wide.
Leaves green but very bright red when under
direct sunlight and turned a pale yellow
when in shade. No flowers or fruit seen.
Leaves entire and opp. at nodes from 1.5 to 2.5 cm.
in length and 1.5 cm. wide. Leaflets
oblong and pointed.
