APPENDIX A

THE GENUS IRIS

STATEMENT BY THE AMERICAN IRIS SOCIETY

This list includes, as far as possible, all species and varieties now in American commerce. Names are arranged alphabetically in *three Groups*: GROUP I, Bearded Iris (Pogoniris); GROUP II, Beardless Iris (Apogon) and Crested Iris (Evansia); GROUP III, Bulbous and Miscellaneous, because these Groups are distinct both botanically and horticulturally. These names are taken from the check list of the American Iris Society, seventh revision, Dec., 1921, which gives all species and varieties that have ever been introduced into commerce, or that have been named by breeders for future introduction. For the Official Catalogue of Standardized Plant Names, this complete list has been shortened by omitting (a) all varieties now believed to be obsolete, and (b) newly named varieties which have not yet (Dec. 31, 1921) been introduced into commerce. These new varieties are published as a supplement to this list. Except for these omissions, GROUP I is believed to be fairly complete. Many names have been shortened and a few have been changed to conform to the American Joint Committee's Rules of Nomenclature. GROUP II, especially as regards Japanese Iris (*kaempferi* varieties), is not as complete as GROUP I. The present chaos in the nomenclature of these varieties is due to (1) the carelessness or unscrupulousness of certain Japanese nurserymen in sending out varieties incorrectly labeled; (2) the difficulty of spelling Japanese names; (3) the free translation of Japanese names in Europe and America; and (4) the common practice of rechristening Japanese varieties in Europe and America. To obviate the difficulties outlined in (2) the American Iris Society has authorized the registration of the translated names as outlined in (3). The names mentioned in (4) cannot be accepted as they differ in every nursery. GROUP III is by no means complete.

Name of originator and date of introduction are given in parentheses where these facts have been ascertainable. Sources of information are believed to be accurate but are not guaranteed.

GROUP I. BEARDED IRIS (POGONIRIS)

(Commonly known as German Iris)

This group comprises the well-known garden Iris derived from species from southern Europe and Asia Minor, some of them known in cultivation for more than two hundred years. The distinguishing characteristics are (1) the conspicuous "beard" on the lower petal or "fall"; (2) the root which is a rhizome and which will stand long exposure to air and drought without injury after the manner of bulbs. The plants of this group need well-drained soil and sunny exposure.

STANDARDIZED PLANT NAMES

GROUP II. BEARDLESS IRIS (APOGON) AND
CRESTED IRIS (EVANSIA)

This group is derived from species from Europe, Asia, and America, which, as a rule, prefer moist soils. The root is a rhizome, but fibrous, and, like most herbaceous plants, will not stand long exposure to air and drought. The leaves are more grass-like than those of Pogoniris, while the flower, as is indicated by the name, lacks the "beard" on the "fall" of the Pogoniris varieties.

GROUP III. BULBOUS AND MISCELLANEOUS IRIS.

Under this heading are grouped partial lists of bulbous and other varieties commonly grown in Europe, but which are not now generally obtainable in American nurseries.

SPECIAL NOTE

It is realized that this preliminary list contains errors and omissions, and all persons receiving it are requested to check it over carefully and to send corrections or additions to the secretary, so that a more authentic list can be published in the future. The names of species in **black type**, and of varieties in **SMALL CAPITALS**, are, by the publication of this list, accepted and given registration of name by the American Iris Society and by the American Joint Committee on Horticultural Nomenclature. No objection to the registration of any of the species or varieties in the list will be considered unless made within two months of the date of publication. GROUP I

BEARDED IRIS

Classification and Abbreviations

- DB.** Dwarf Bearded Iris. Species, forms, and hybrids of *Iris pumila*, *chamaeiris*, *aphylla*, etc.
- INT.** Intermediate Iris. Hybrids between the Dwarf Bearded varieties mentioned above and the Tall Bearded varieties mentioned below, as well as some miscellaneous varieties, which are generally classed with them.
- TB.** Tall Bearded Iris. Species, forms, and hybrids of *Iris germanica*, *pallida*, *variegata*, *trojana*, *cypriana*, etc.
- MB.** Miscellaneous Bearded Iris. Hybrids between the species of the groups *Oncocylus*, *Regelia*, and *Evansia* Iris and species of the group *Pogoniris*; includes also some miscellaneous kinds which do not readily fall in the other sections.

Names have been shortened where possible; therefore, for names usually catalogued beginning with *albicans*, *aphylla*, *Balcerg*, *biflora*, *Cengialti*, *chamaeiris*, *cypriana*, *flavescens*, *germanica*, *kashmiriana*, *lutescens*, *olbiensis*, *pallida*, *pumila*, *sambucina*, *squalens*, *trojana*, *variegata*, also *Comte*, *Comtesse*, *Count*, *Countess*, *Die*, *Duc*, *Duchesse*, *Duke*, *Duchess*, *General*, *King*, *L'*, *La*, *Le*, *Les*, *Lady*, *Lord*, *Mlle.*, *Miss*, *Monsieur*, *Mr.*, *President*, *Prince*, *Princess*, *Queen*, *Reine*, *Roi*, *Sir*, *Souvenir*, *The*, *Viscount*, and which are not found with these prefixes, see in alphabetical position of last name.

Many names are printed in *synonym* type but no recommended name is given. This indicates that no authority for use of this name has been found and that it is believed to be an old variety renamed; absolute identification is not possible, however, at the present time, but it is hoped such identification will be given in the next edition of the check list.

Names of accepted **species** are in **black type**.

Names of accepted **VARIETIES** are in **SMALL CAPITALS**.
