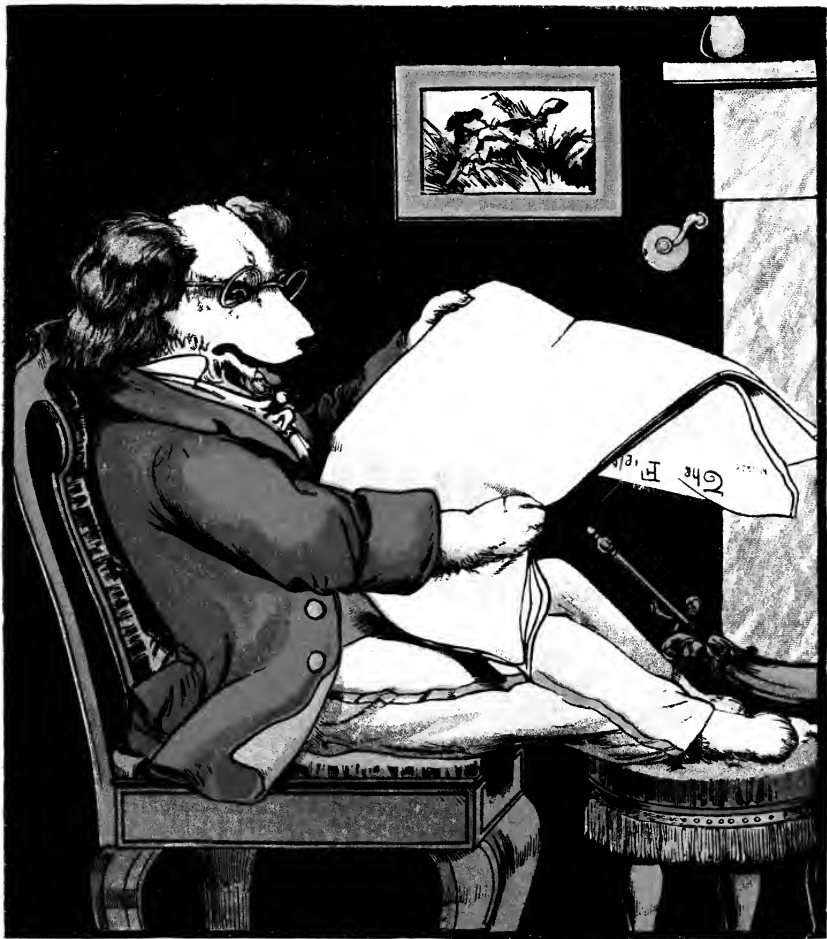

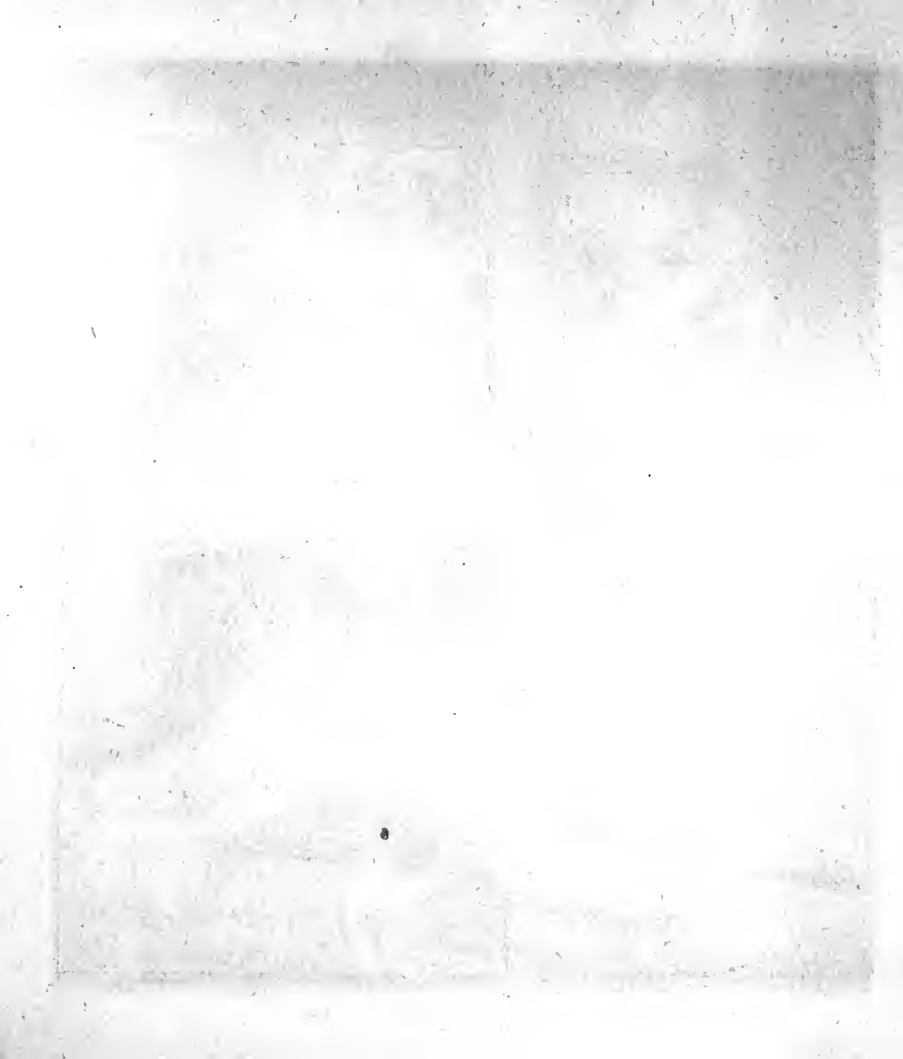

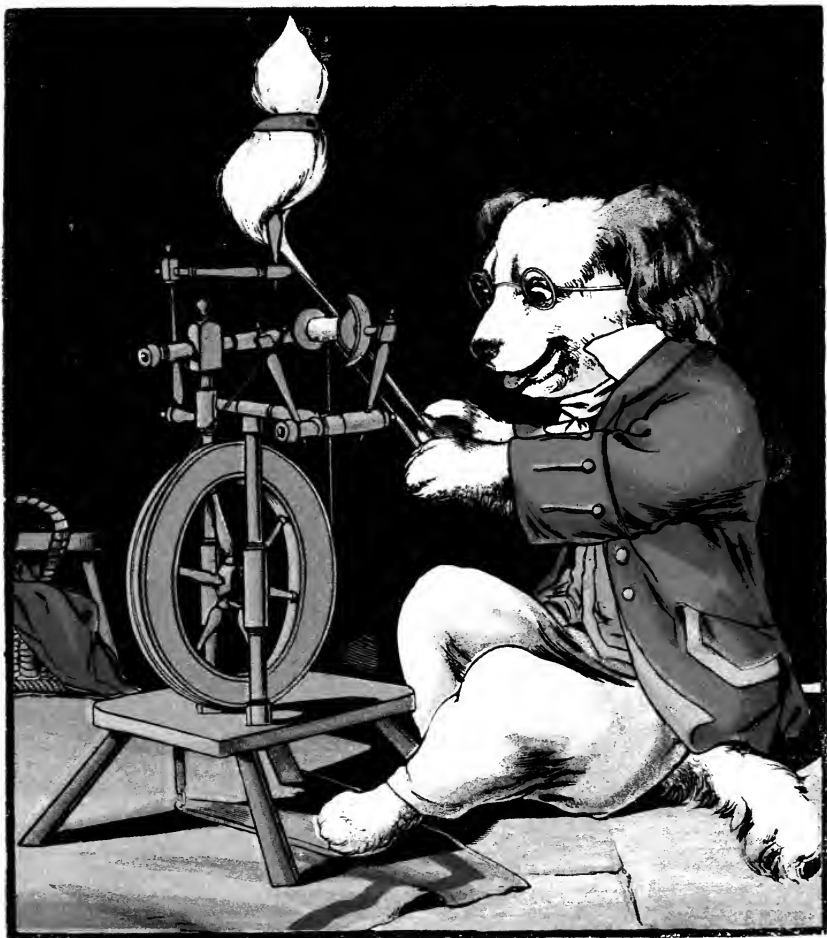

He was riding a goat!

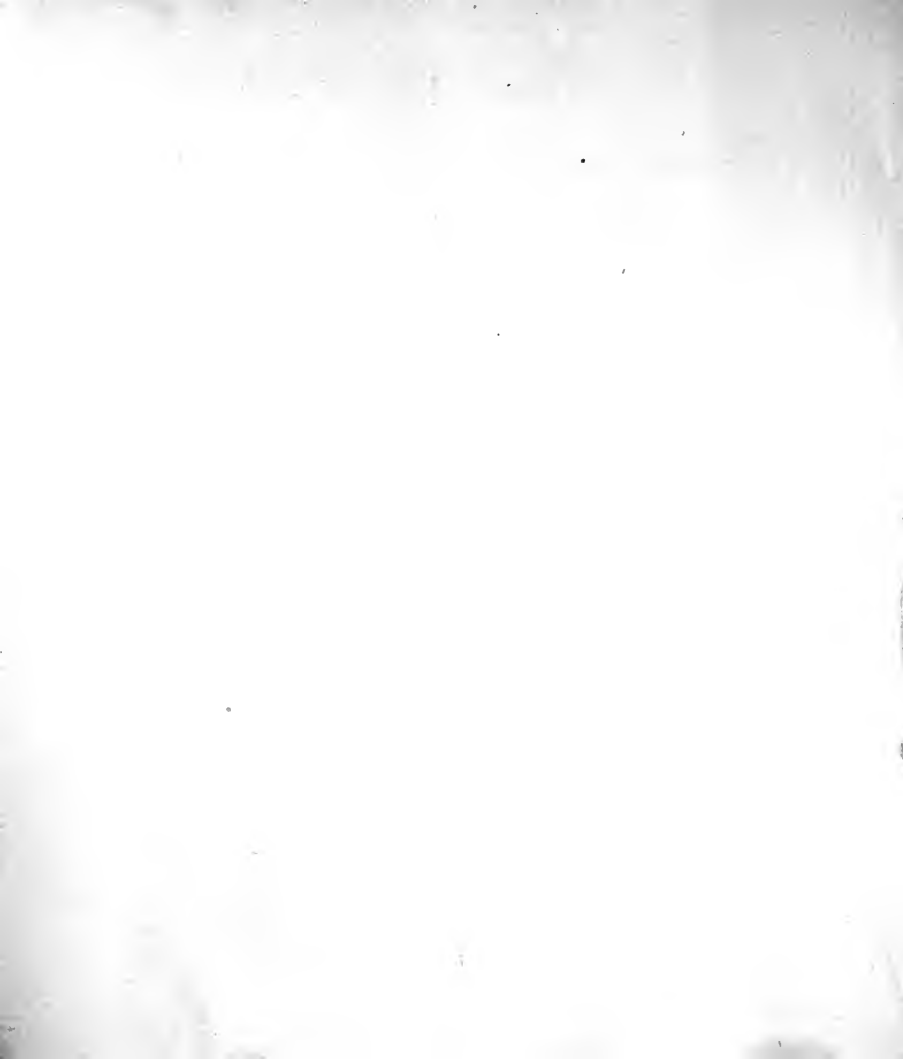
Mother Hubbard's Dog.
