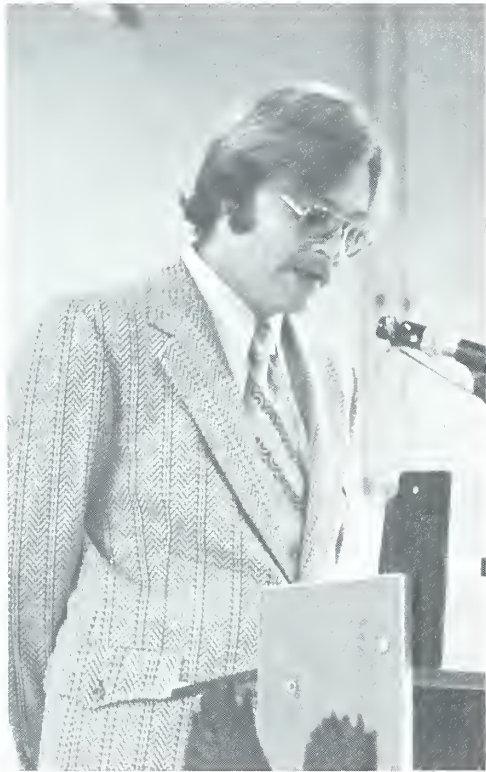
WHO'S WHO

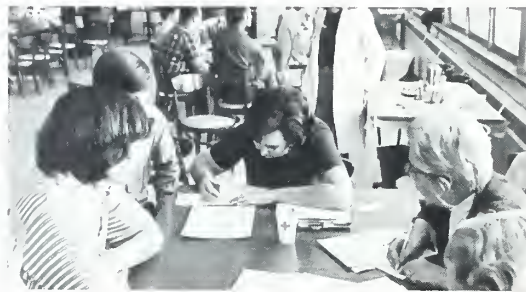




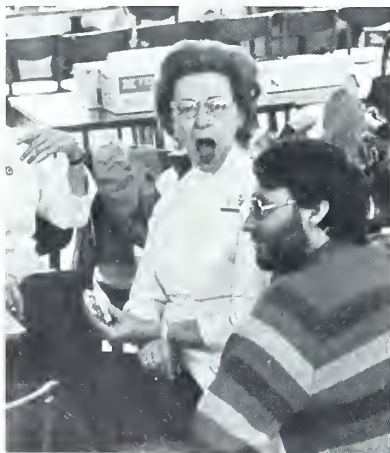
MASTERPIECES OF CULINARY ART

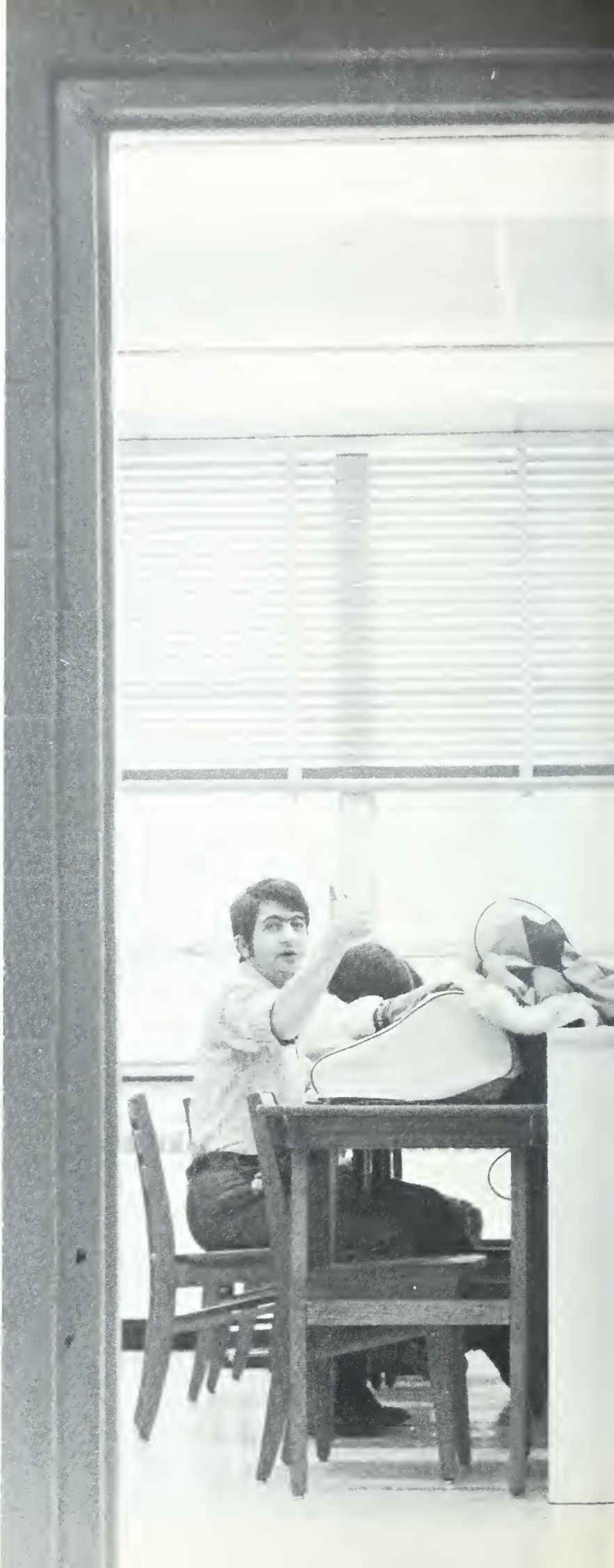


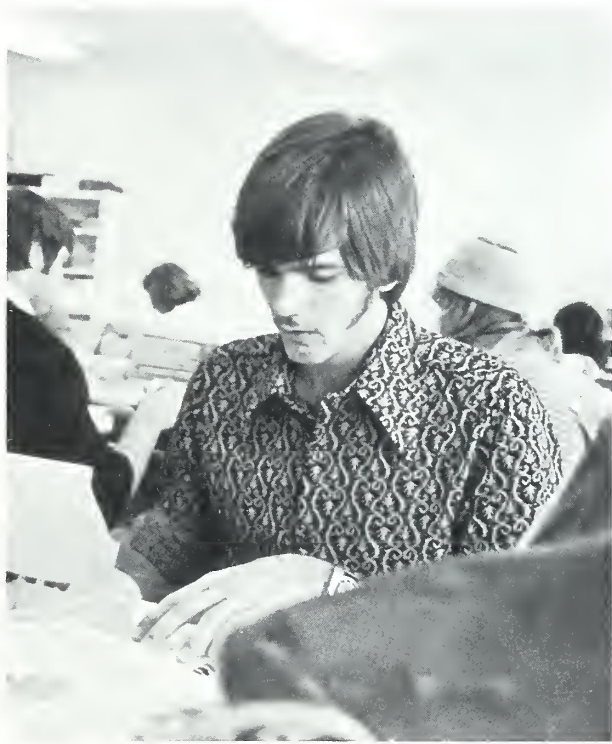










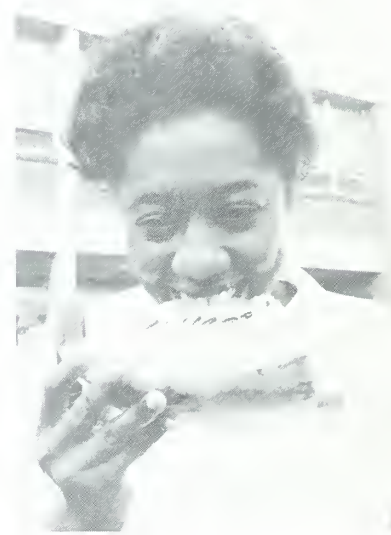
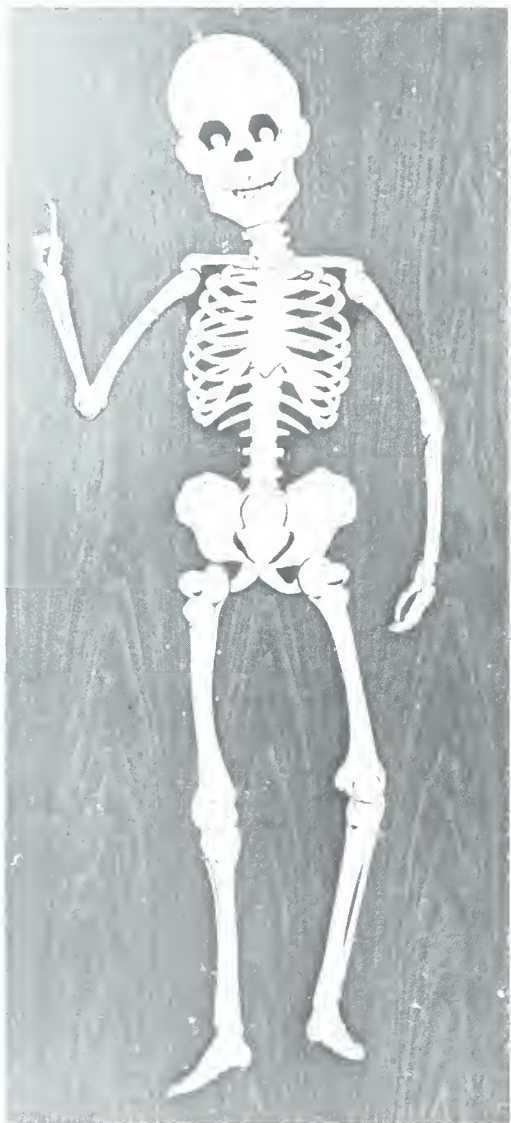
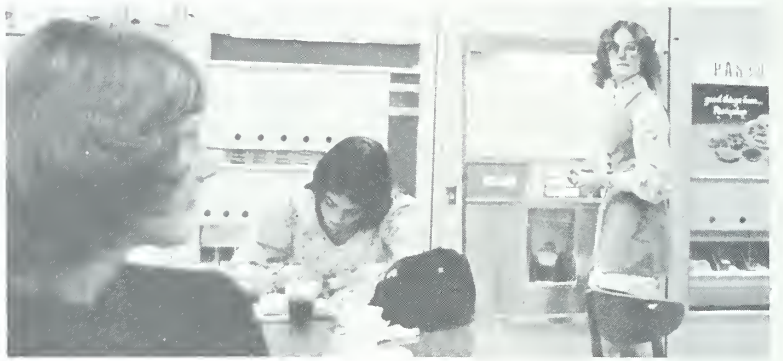


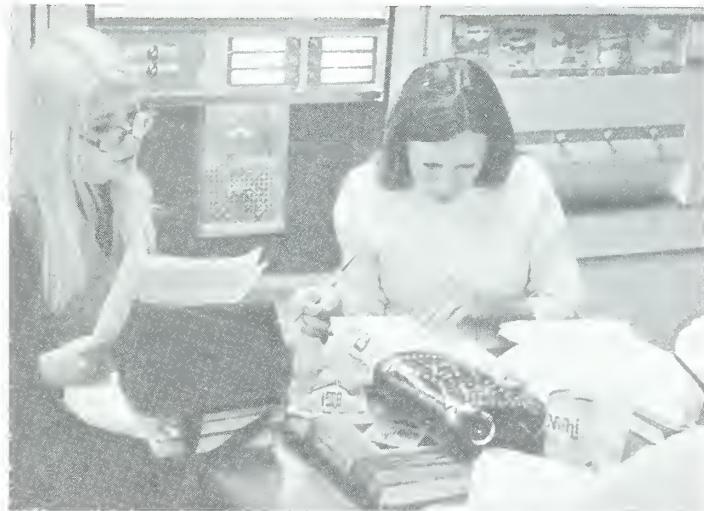




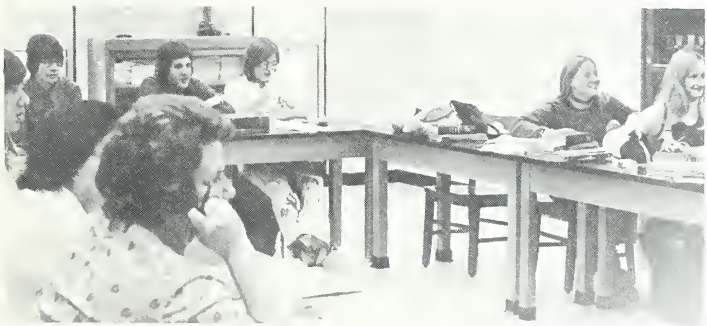




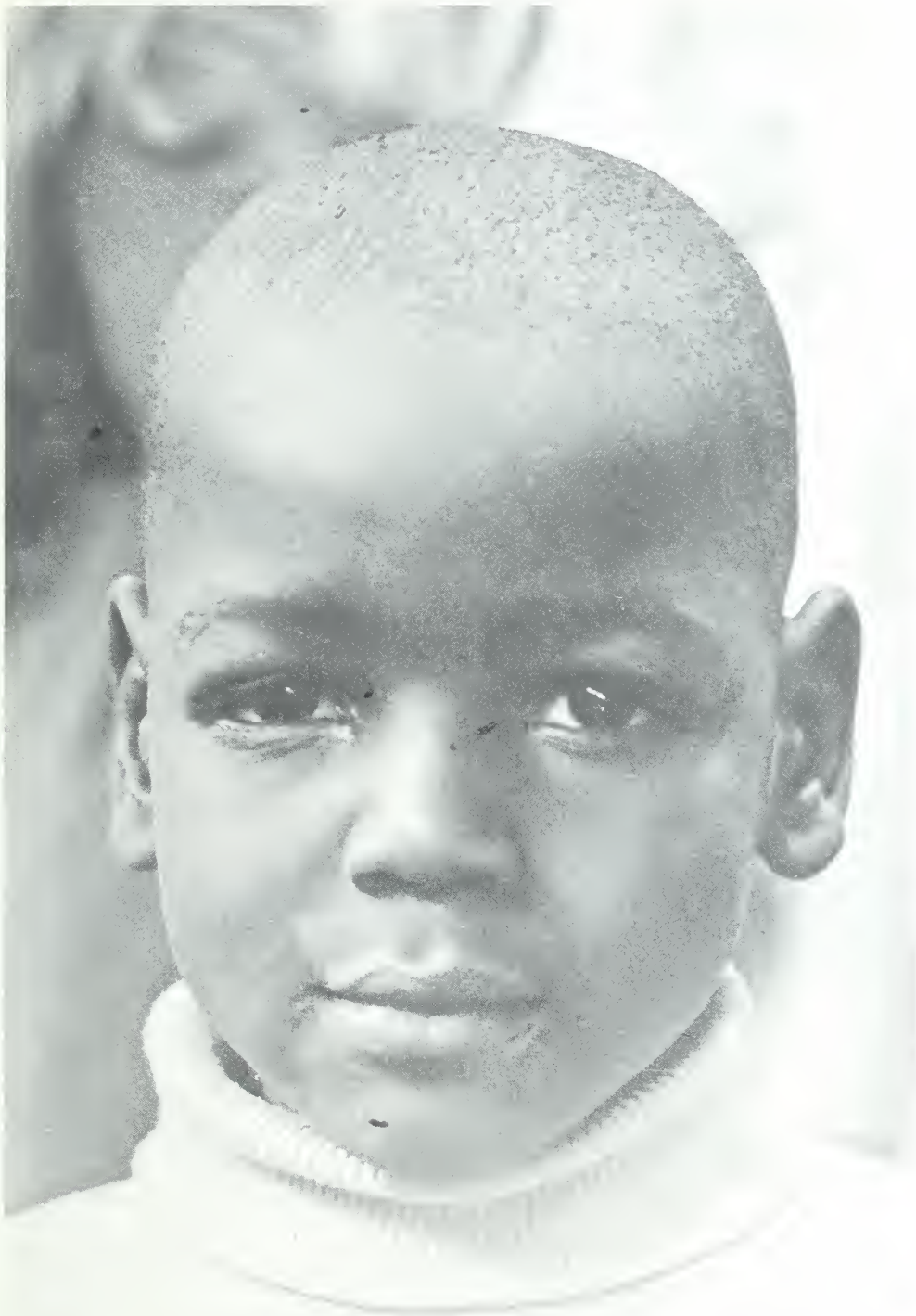












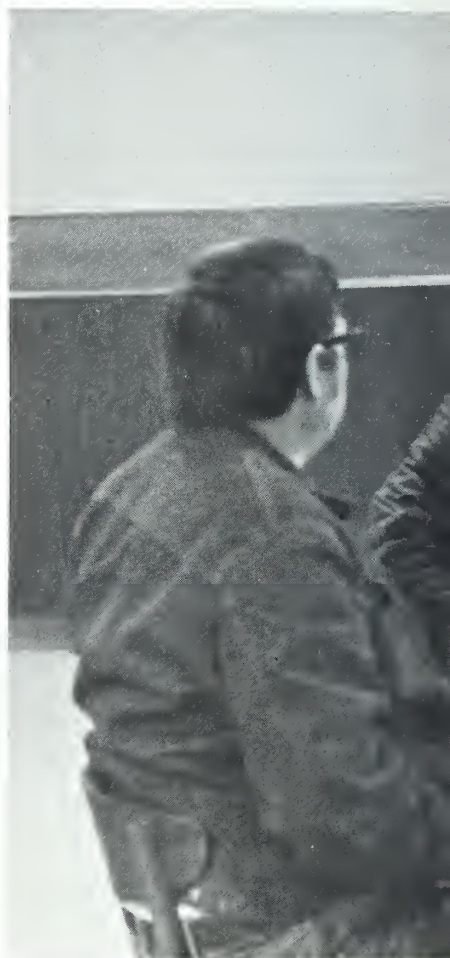
THINK SNOW!
