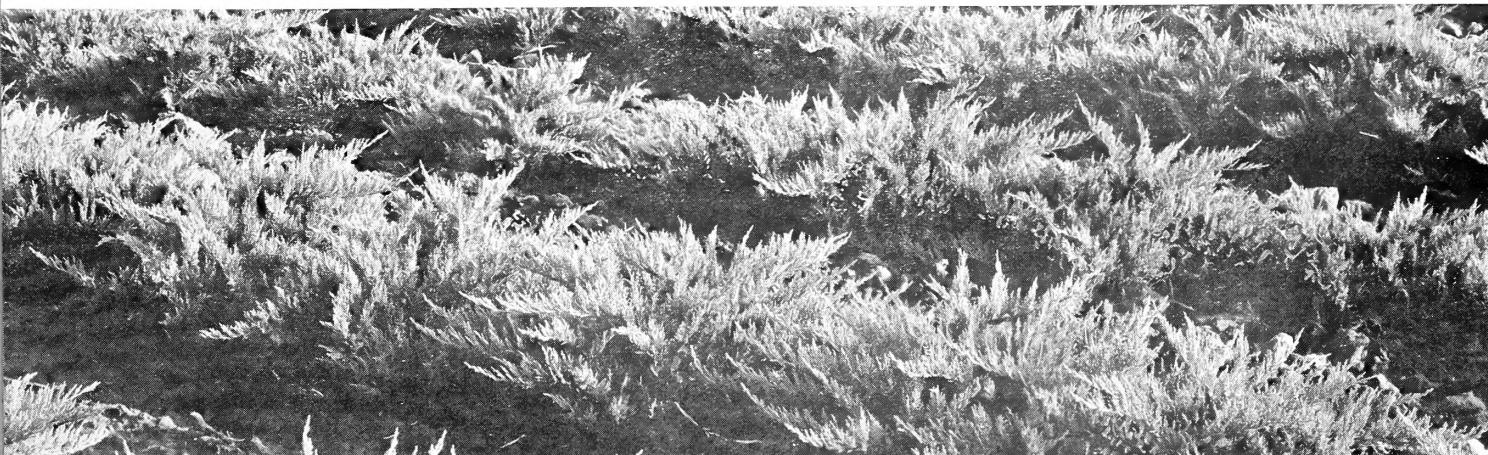

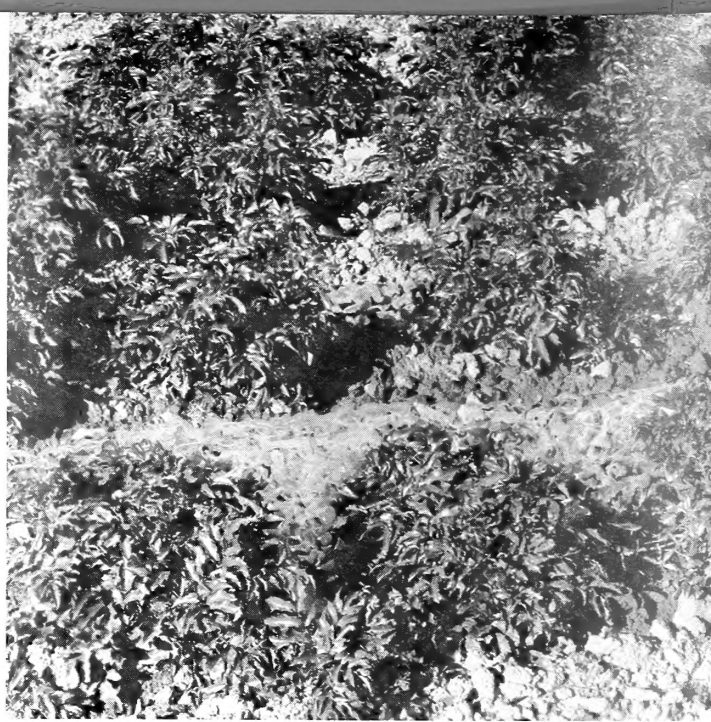

Salt Lake City, Utah, and are forwarded at your expense for transportation charges via the most convenient and economical way: Rail Freight, Motor Freight, or Express, specify whichever is best for you. Send no money for transportation charges, which will be collected when delivery is made, unless yours is a prepaid station where there is no agent. Unless you specify the way, we will use our best judgment in forwarding.

Please Use Catalog Numbers, together with name of the article, size, quantity, and price in making up your order. Also, where possible, use this order blank which folds into a self-addressed envelope. Extras furnished on request.

When necessary to make additional explanation or inquiry, please do so on a separate sheet of paper. You may send money conveniently and safely in the form of a post office money order, express order, or your personal check. Please do not send stamps.

Please send remittance in full with order, as we are without facilities for credit accounting.

C. O. D. shipments are not advisable—Because of the wide variation in the proper planting time of seed and nursery stock, it is most often necessary to forward in separate shipments. The weight of the separate parts determine the most economical way to ship, whether via freight, express or mail. Under such conditions it is difficult to handle these divisions promptly without duplication of C. O. D. fees. Then also a deposit of at least 25% is required before shipments can be made.
