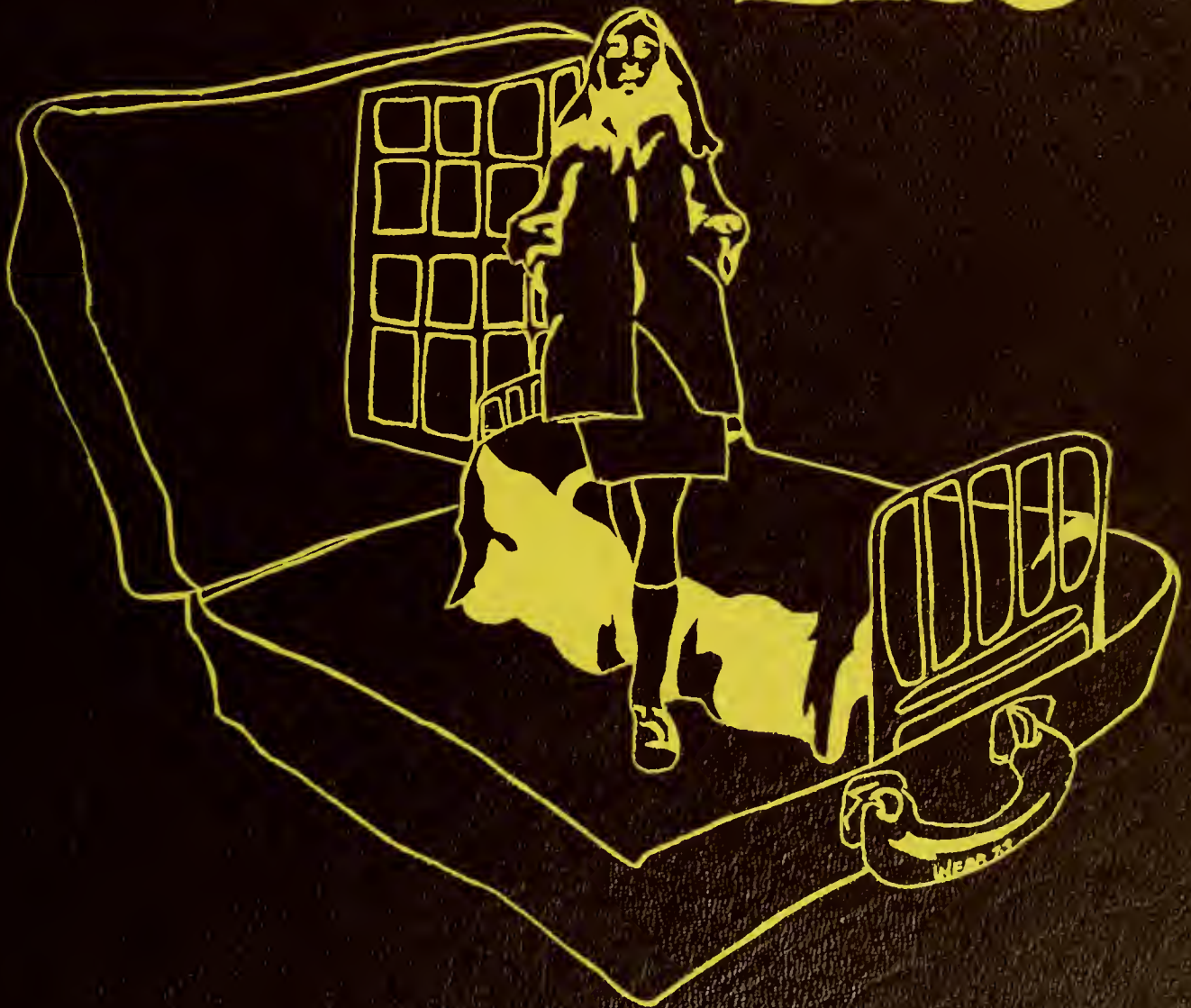

that was short lived.



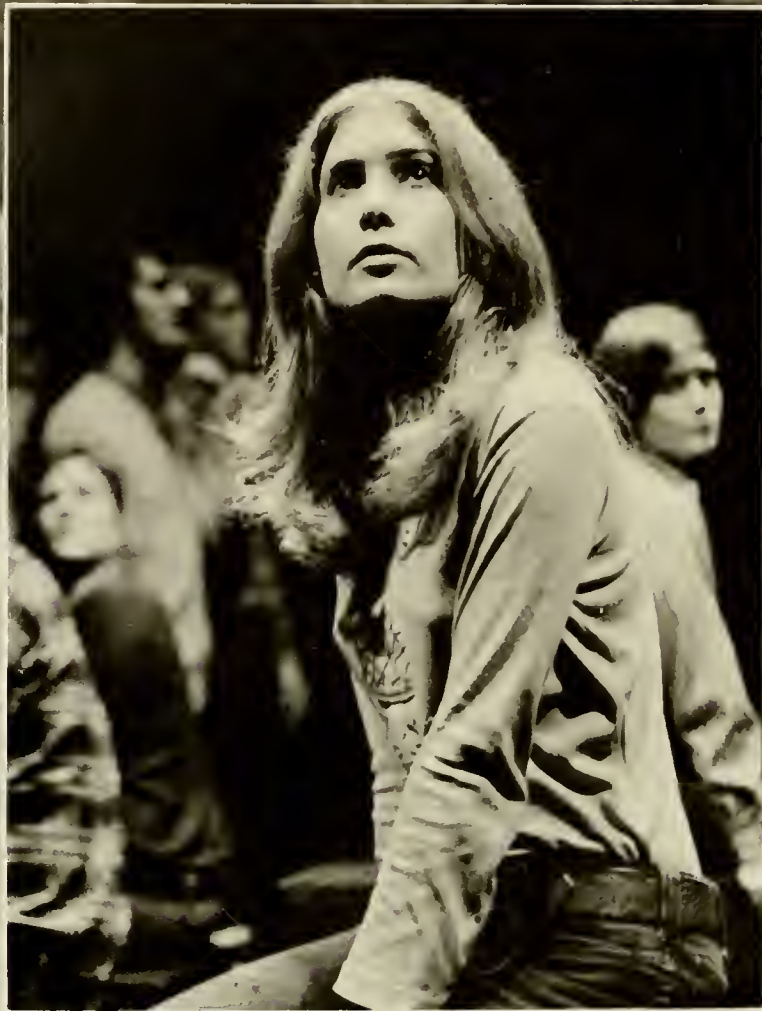
