The "Bobcats" finished the season with the best record in the history of Lees-McRae as they capped the Junior College Conference with six wins and one tie. The tie came with the first conference tilt against Gardner-Webb. All games were played on the home field, with the exception of Belmont Abbey.

The game with Milligan will long be remembered by both the players and the students. Low-hanging clouds covered the water soaked, muddy, field, and a cold wind kept everyone shivering; but in spite of their handicap, the "Bobcats" emerged as the victors of the game.

The "Bobcats" are proud to have had three men named for the All Conference team, which is picked every year by the coaches of the Junior Colleges. All three of the "Bobcat" men were elected by unanimous vote. Lindsay Golloway was elected to the backfield on his triple threat running, as he carried the ball 106 times for a gain of 550 yards; scored four touchdowns himself, and passed for 6 more. Golloway was also elected as the All Conference co-captain.

Don Roberts was elected with all first place votes to the end position for his outstanding defensive work. Don was among the top defensive players in the conference. He was also elected as the most valuable player on the "Bobcat" team.

Fred Lyle was unanimously elected to the guard position for sturdy defensive and offensive play. Fred made the All Conference guard spot for two consecutive years and received the trophy for the most valuable "Bobcat" player in '47.

Elbert Peters of Riedsville, big

210 pound fullback, and Johnny Crowley, the 162 pound quarterback from Wilmington, showed up exceptionally well during the season.

Lost, but not least, the team thanks the leaders of the All Conference Club, Coach Fred Dickerson and Assistant Coach Paul McEwen. They have had headaches and troubles through the season, but have always been patient in their dealings with the team. Through their drills and teaching the "Bobcats" have received the honor of the junior College Conference Champions of 1948.

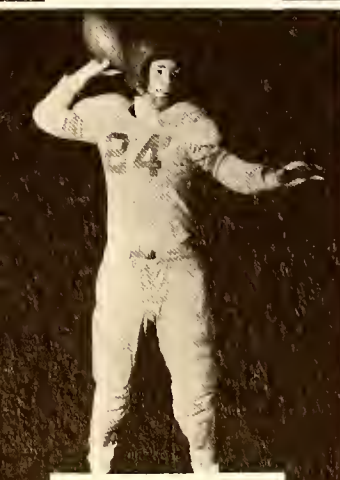

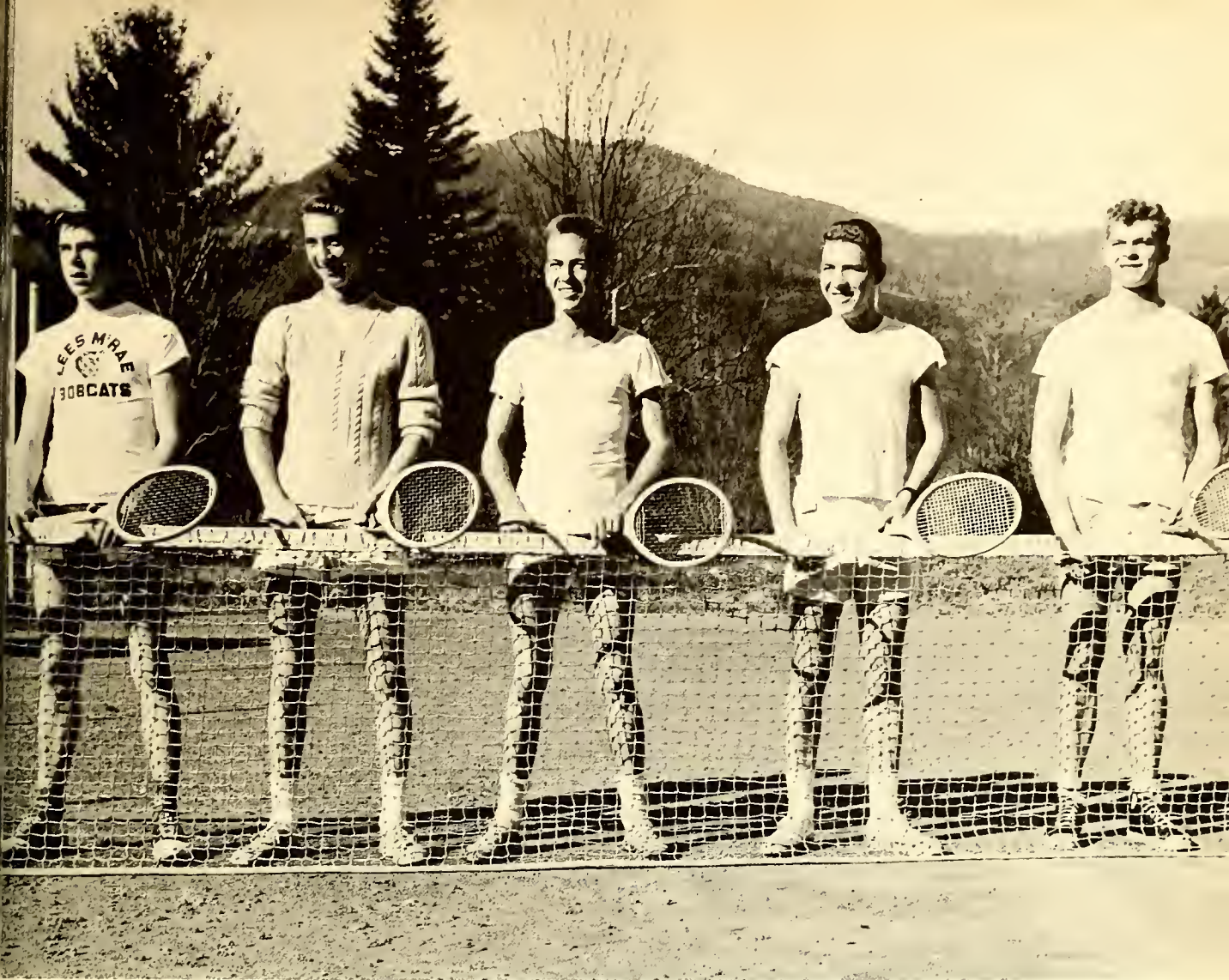
Cross Country Team

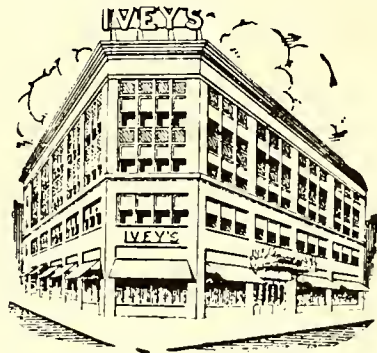
