

One of the goals the F.H.A. has is to send gifts to the mental patients at Broughton. This helps the F.H.A. ers realize the importance of sharing with others.


The F.H.A. has as other goals: the fashion show, the Christmas program for assembly, and participation in County F.H.A. Workshops.
