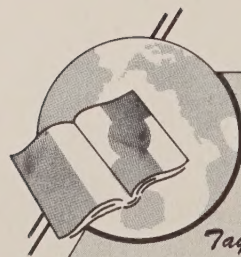
On Thursday, May 22, twelve members
