

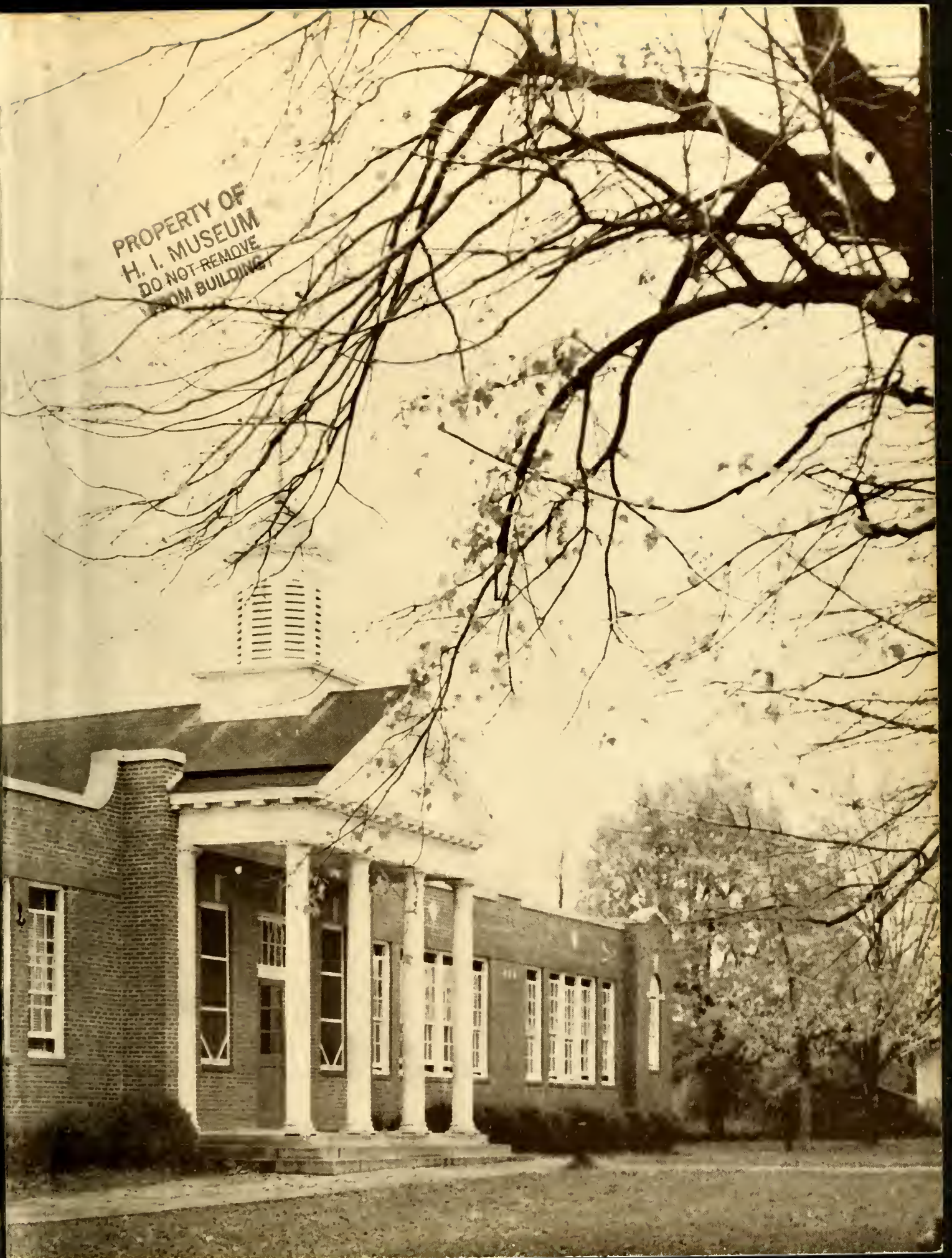

Imagine for a moment that you are once again in the 9th grade. Then, "look-up" through the years to 1958. Recall the turns in national and world history you have experienced.

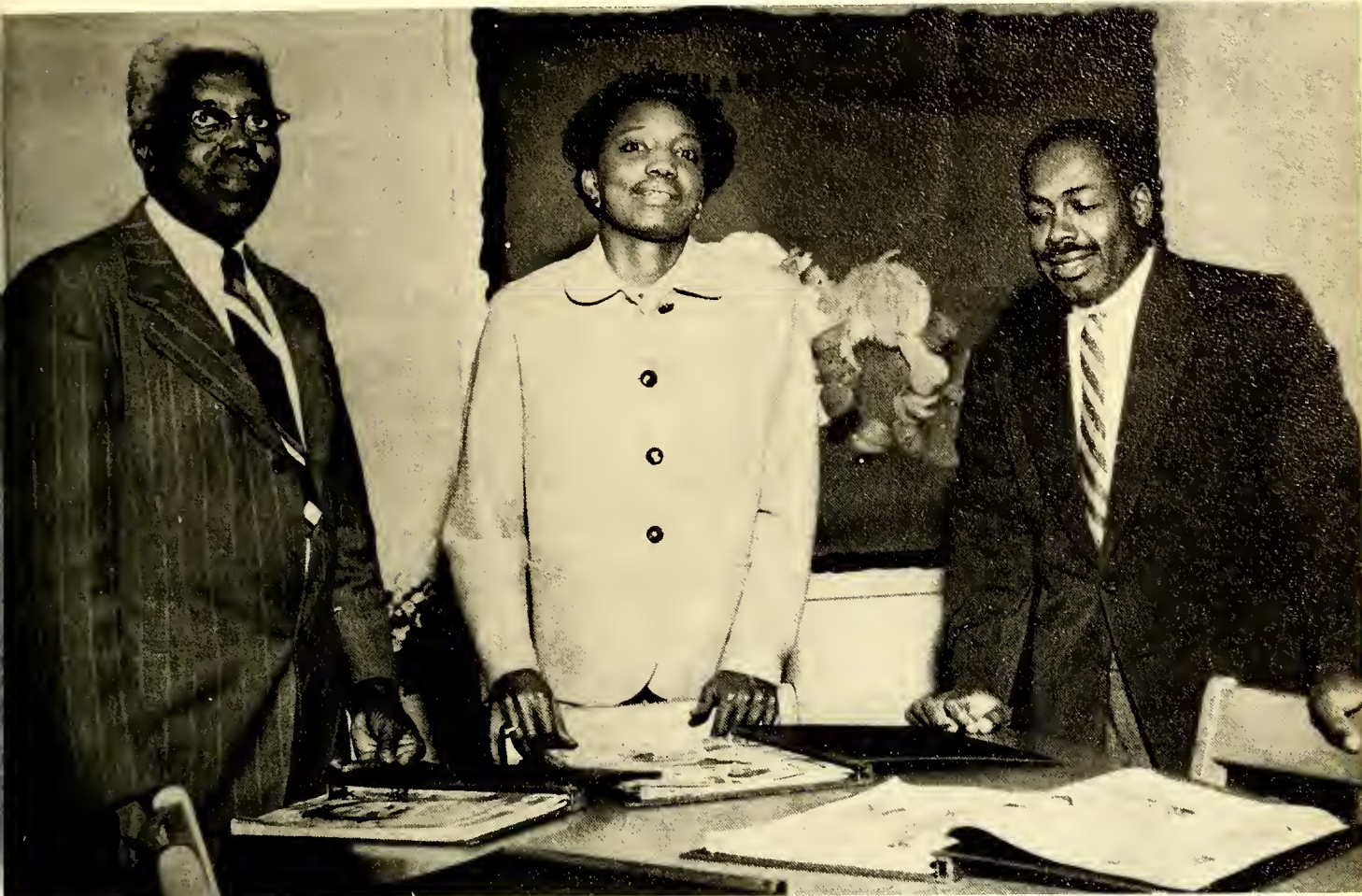
Have your high school experiences been as effective in laying a foundation for the next four years as historical trends have been?
