The Panthers of Henderson Institute tasted defeat for the first time in 23 games when they were edged 14-8 by Lincoln High of Chapel Hill, Homecoming night. This was also the first night contest for the locals under the recently installed lighting system.

The visitors drew first blood as they marched 67 yards with a bruising ground attack mixed with short passes. The Tigers drove inside the Henderson 10 yard line where it was first and goal the Institutes forward wall three straight downs but with fourth and 4, Lincoln quarterback, Fred Baldwin sneaked over through the line.
