Class History

In August of the year, 1959, seventy-three freshmen arrived at Newbold High School to begin building the first stage of the rocket that would carry them on their journey through life. This was also the year that a new school organization came into being: the Home Economics club. The majority of the sophomore girls joined the club and received recognition as being outstanding members.

The sophomores were also well represented in the dramatic club by four students; Patsy Foster, Bernita Carson, Mildred Bracy, and Leslie Friday.

Finally, the second stage was completed and the sophomores left victorious, to return in the fall, and begin work on their third stage.

When they returned as juniors in the fall of 1961, they resumed their task with an even greater determination to see the rocket completed. Mrs. McDaniel was their advisor that year. Class officers were Alfred Morrison, Benjamin Sowell, Betty Curry, and Allene Link. The year started with a big bang! Louise Hush was Miss Homecoming!

The Juniors were represented on the football team by Rudolph Young, Leslie Friday, James Landers, and Lewis Sanders, and on the basketball team by Frank Wingate, Clarence Lindsay, and Lewis Sanders. Geraldine McRavion was captain of the cheering squad.

Allene Patterson, Rachel McClain, Louise Hush, Patsy Foster, Geraldine McRavion, Marie Stamey, Mary Tinsley, and Corrine Bryant joined the N.H.A. Club.

Leslie Friday, Libby Gibbs, and Betty Curry were student council officers. Brenda Blake and Bernita Carson were council representatives.

The finalists in the oratorical contest in which the entire junior class participated, were Rachel McClain, Betty Curry, Bernita Carson, Louise Hush, Brenda Blake, Libby Gibbs, Nathaniel Oates, and Rudolph Young. The winners were Betty Curry, Rachel McClain, Brenda Blake, Louise Hush, and Bernita Carson.

The year was crowned by the Junior-Senior prom. The theme of the prom was "Ebb Tide". To many of the class members, this was the most exciting event before the completion of the third stage in the spring of 1962.

Now, as we, the senior class of 1963, who were once the seventy-three freshmen, work toward completion of the final stage, we reflect upon those by-gone years with admiration for those who have been our guides. We are still working diligently under the leadership of our sponsor, Mrs. Watts, to realize our goal and keep the banner of our performance high among the ranks of those who have gone before, and will follow us.

Class officers are Leslie Friday, Rudolph Young, Travis Nixon, Rachel McClain, Libby Gibbs, Lewis Sanders, and Bobby Huff.

Representing us in various areas have been Bernita Carson, an attendant to Miss Homecoming; Libby Gibbs, who was crowned Miss Newbold; and Brenda Blake, who was Miss N.H.A., with Travis Nixon as her attendant.

Six seniors, Rudolph Young, Lewis Sanders, Leslie Friday, James Landers, Bobby Huff, and Clarence Lindsay kept the football team alive.

Alfred Morrison, Robert Thompson, and Lewis Sanders represent us on the basketball team.

We wish to thank our parents and teachers who have helped us, in the words of our motto, to "Climb though the rocks be rugged".
