A Senior and a five feet, eleven inches, one hundred ninety pound Guard. "Mike" has contributed to his team's success by averaging twenty-five tackles a game.

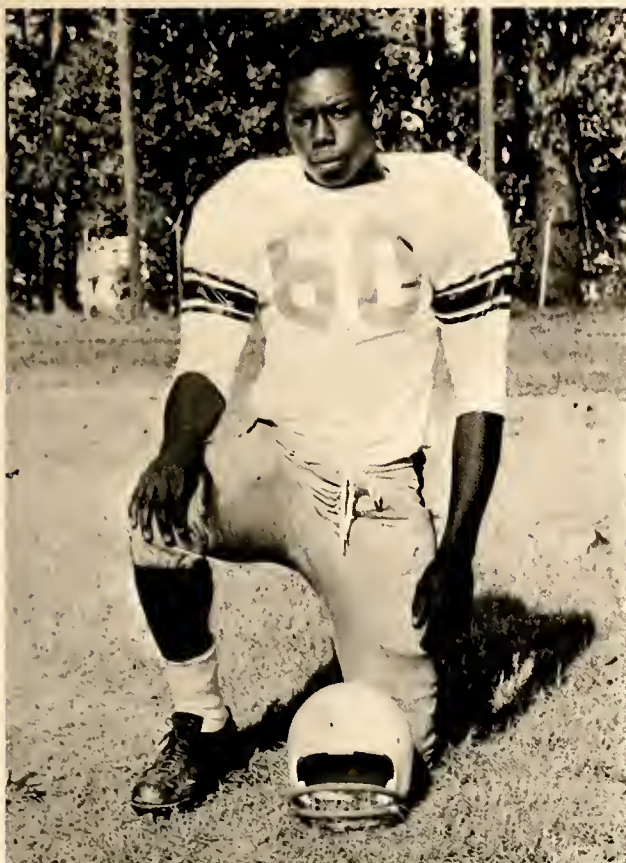

A Junior, six feet, two hundred pound "Guard". Thompson was a standard performer in the game with Mary Potter. He is likely to be captain next year.

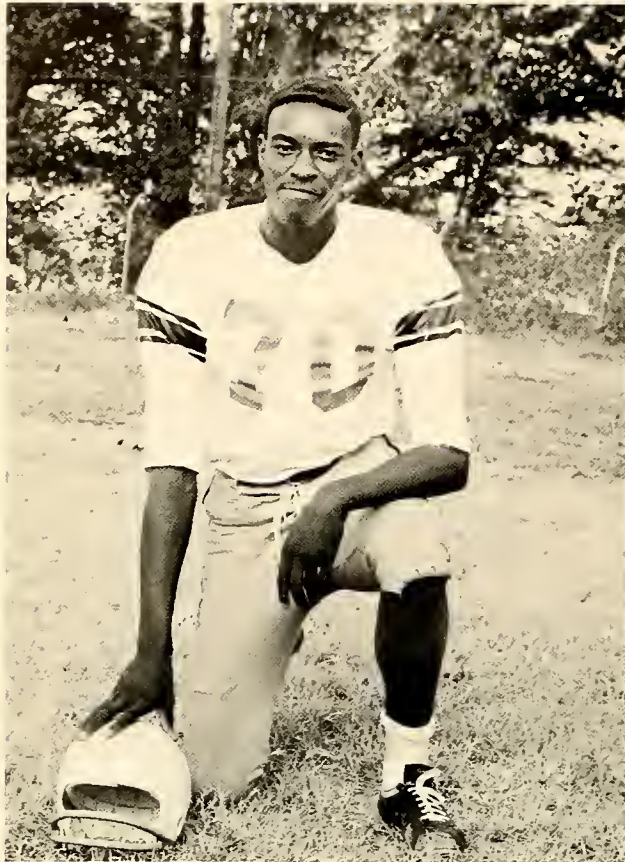
