Foreword

J. M. Fulton was the founder of Henderson Normal Institute in 1891 under the direction of the United Presbyterian Church. There were five teachers including the principal, 350 pupils in day school and 90 pupils in night school.

C. L. McCracken's (1893-1898) leadership produced a new teacher and new rooms were added to the old building. Under his administration the first commencement was held with Thomas Burwell as the only graduate.

Albert H. Porter was principal from 1898-1899. Rev. J. D. W. Johnson succeeded Mr. Porter and also served one year.

The first Negro principal was Rev. J. L. Cook (1900-1903). Under his administration the name was changed to Henderson Institute.

Henderson Institute progressed under the administration of Dr. J. A. Cotton (1903-1934). By 1903 the faculty had increased to twelve teachers, the students to four hundred and the boarders numbered well into the hundreds. Many came as far away as New York, Pennsylvania, Massachusetts and Virginia. The boys lived in Witherspoon Hall and the girls in Fulton Hall. The latter is still standing.

When the county and state began paying for operating the school, the boarding students moved away and local students attended.

During Dr. O. T. Robinson's administration (1934-1947) the school became accredited in 1945.

Mr. L. E. Spencer is the present principal of Henderson Institute. Under his administration the school has experienced many improvements: three buildings have been added; the old buildings are gradually being torn down; nine school buses serve the school; there are 948 students and 38 teachers. Henderson Institute is now one of three high schools in the county with grades 9-12.

We congratulate the matchless leadership and pray that this school shall continue to exert the educational, spiritual, moral and civic influence upon this city, state, and nation as she has in the past years of her existence.
