The track team may not break any world records or even make the Olympic team this year, but they will perform well.

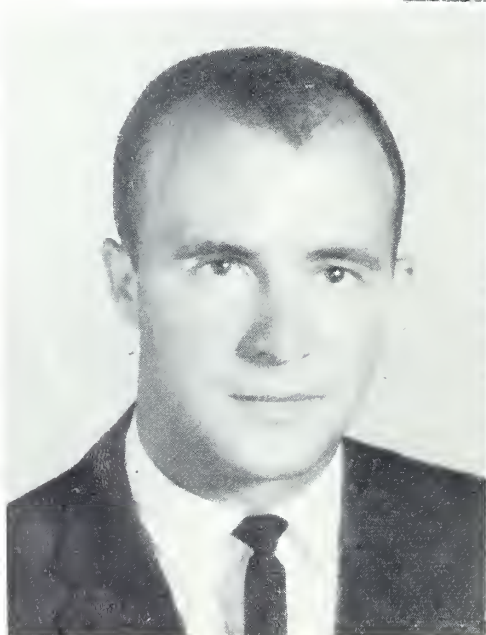
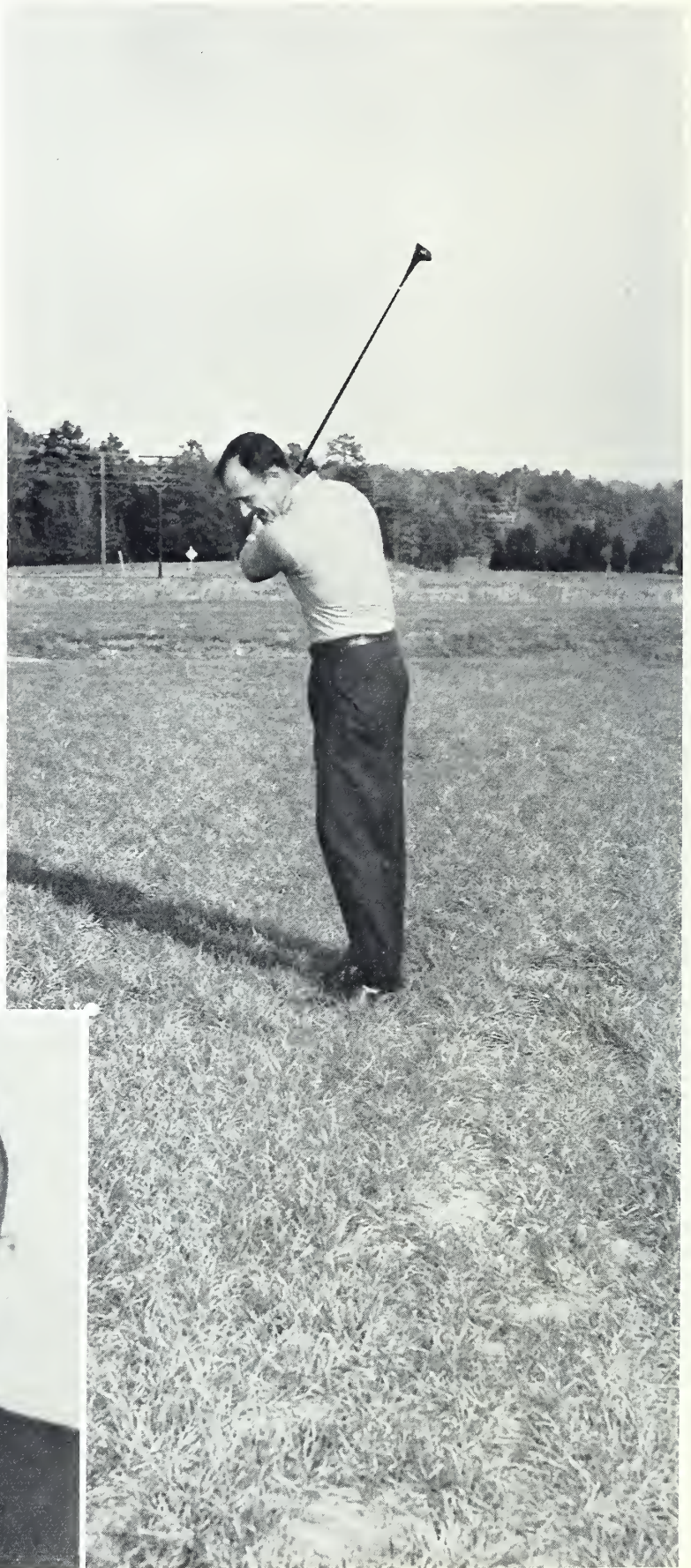

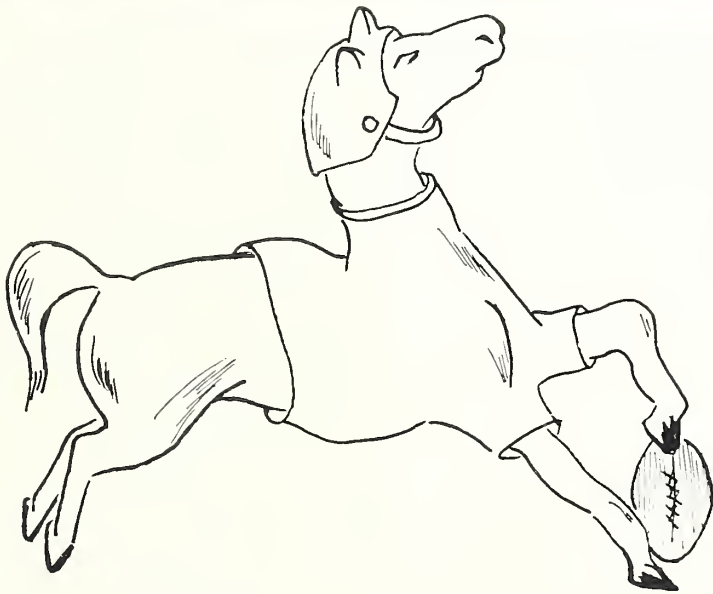
These marshals, who were chosen in their junior year on the basis of leadership, character, and scholastic standing, served during baccalaureate and graduation.
