No Charge for Boxes or Packing. Bags and Barrels only we charge for, and these at cost.

At these low rates, not less than $\frac{1}{4}$ lb. or $\frac{1}{4}$ bushel in Vegetable Seeds will be furnished, nor less than 25 lbs. at 100 pound rate; when less quantities than these are ordered, we charge retail rates allowing a discount of 30 per cent. Where Flower Seeds are priced at 50 cents per oz. or less, no smaller quantities than $\frac{1}{2}$ oz. will be furnished at ounce rates.

VEGETABLE SEEDS.

We think a careful examination of our prices this season will disclose quotations exceptionally low. As a rule the prices are much below the rates we have made in previous seasons. There are a few exceptions, however, where we have been compelled to make an advance on account of great scarcity of seed. Such instances are *Bush Beans* of nearly all sorts, *Cucumbers*, *Squash* and some of the late varieties of *Sweet Corn*. With these few exceptions, however, we are satisfied that our rates for first quality of stock are very low. We shall, as far as possible, adhere closely to the rates here given, but we reserve the right to advance the price without notice, should our stocks become depleted. We also reserve the right to decline orders for any one variety, should the demand for it be likely to force us to shorten up customers who annually depend upon us for their general supply of seeds.

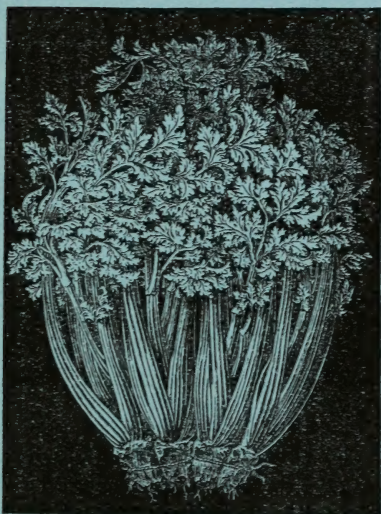

The great bugbear in the cultivation of Celery, by those engaged in growing it for market, has been the labor entailed in the "banking" or earthing up, to whiten or blanch it; and with the unskilled amateur growing a few hundred for private use, the troublesome process of "banking" has usually been a detriment sufficient to prevent him from trying. Now he can grow this new sort just as simply as any other vegetable, the culture in all respects being the same as that of the older sorts, except we are saved the trouble of high banking. In size and weight it is similar to those popular kinds, "Golden Dwarf" and "Henderson's Half Dwarf." Our illustration shows a bunch of four, the usual way in which Celery is put up for the New York market.

The peculiarity of the Celery known as "White Plume" is, that NATURALLY its stalk and portions of its inner leaves and heart are white, so that, by closing the stalks, either by tying them up with matting, or by simply drawing the soil against the plant and pressing it together with the hands, and again drawing up the soil with the hoe or plow, so as to keep the soil that has been squeezed against the Celery in its place, the work of blanching is completed; while it is well known that in all other kinds of Celery, in addition to this, the slow and troublesome process of high "banking" with the spade is a necessity.

It is well known that one-half the value of a Celery, particularly in our best hotels and restaurants, is held to be its fitness as a table ornament, and for this purpose this new variety is admirably fitted. In addition to this, its eating qualities are equal to the very best of the older sorts, be-
