COASTAL BERMUDA GRASS (CERTIFIED)

Feb. 15 to April 15 is generally regarded as the best and safest time to set out stolons or sprigs of Coastal Bermuda. We are digging now—when the ground is dry enough. Use 3,000 to 5,000 per acre.
