PROPAGATION AND DISTRIBUTION OF FISHES FROM HATCHERIES AND FISHERY RESOURCE MANAGEMENT FOR FY 1980

INTRODUCTION

This report on fishes and fish eggs distributed by national fish hatcheries for the period October 1, 1980, to September 30, 1981, is a continuation of a series of publications issued since 1872. Records of hatchery outputs were published in the annual Commissioner's Report of the U.S. Commission of Fish and Fisheries through 1903 and in the Annual Report of the Commissioner of Fisheries of the U.S. Department of Commerce, until 1940. From 1941 through 1962, these tabulations were presented as "Statistical Digest". Beginning in 1963, these reports became known as the "Fish Distribution Report". Report No. 2 for 1965 and 1966 established the fiscal year as the period of coverage. In 1976, the fiscal year time frame was changed from July through June to October through September. Report No. 11 recorded fish distribution for the period of July 1, 1975 through September 20, 1976, which included the 3 month transition quarter—July, August and September 1976. All future fish distribution reports will coincide with the October through September fiscal year.

The Hatcheries and Fishery Resource Management system produces primarily salmon, trout, catfish, pike, bass, and sunfish. Several additional species of fish are produced and collected for use as test animals in various research projects.

The goal of the Fish and Wildlife Service is to conserve the Nation's freshwater and anadromous fishery resources for the benefit of the people. Distribution of fish from the Federal hatchery system assists in meeting this goal in accordance with the following objectives:

- a. To restore and/or maintain existing freshwater and anadromous fishery resources in suitable streams, rivers or lakes of the United States.
- b. To increase the fisheries by restoring destroyed or depleted fishery resources.
- c. To create greater fisheries by upgrading existing fish populations, developing new bodies of water, and introducing new species.
- d. To aid States in the management and development of fishery resources.
- e. To protect the Nation's fisheries by limiting the introduction or distribution of diseased fish and their attendant pathogens.
- f. To control the introduction and population levels of exotic species damaging to the fishery resources or aquatic ecosystem.

g. To carry out responsibilities established by treaties and other commitments of the Federal Government to maintain or restore fishery resources.

It is the policy of the Fish and Wildlife Service to allocate or distribute the output of its Fish Hatcheries in the following order of priority:

(1) International waters, such as coastal and Great Lakes areas, and waters on land owned, controlled and managed by Federal agencies or recognized Indian tribes (international treaties or cooperative agreements usually involved).

(2) Waters on land owned by the Federal Government and managed by State agencies (cooperative agreements usually involved).

(3) Waters on State or privately owned land managed by a Federal Agency (cooperative agreements usually involved).

(4) Waters which border or cross State boundaries.

(5) Waters owned and managed by State agencies (cooperative agreements occasionally involved).

(6) Privately owned waters.

The present system for allocating fish to the several classes of water has been used by the Federal Government since 1949. The records system used to report stocking of fish was completely revised as of January 1, 1966, to provide more current data and better identification of the various program areas. As a result of the development of fishery management programs, long-range stocking requirements have been determined in many States and Federal areas. Fish stocking requests are now provided by fishery program managers for the various management programs, and it is no longer necessary or desirable to receive individual stocking requests for public waters. Fish are allocated, however, on an individual basis for newly created waters and special programs that meet the present Fish and Wildlife Service criteria for stocking.

Region 4—Richard B. Russell Federal Building, 75 Spring Street, SW., Atlanta, Georgia 30303—Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, Tennessee, Puerto Rico, and the Virgin Islands.

Region 5—One Gateway Center, Suite 700, Newton Corner, Massachusetts 02158—Connecticut, Delaware, Maine, Maryland, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, Vermont, Virginia, West Virginia, and Washington, D.C.

Region 6—Denver Federal Center, (P.O. Box 25486), Denver, Colorado 80225—Colorado, Iowa, Kansas, Missouri, Montana, Nebraska, North Dakota, South Dakota, Utah, and Wyoming.

GLOSSARY

All terms are defined as applied to use in the text of this digest.

Adults: Fish that have attained sexual maturity.

Air Force: Air Force Bases and ranges.

Anadromous fish: A marine fish, such as the salmon, striped bass and shad, that migrates upstream into freshwater to spawn.

Aquarium: Aquaria, exhibition and museums.

Army: Owned or controlled by the Army, excluding Corps of Engineers.

Atlantic Anadromous Program: Enhancement and restoration of anadromous fish species, such as the Atlantic salmon, striped bass, American shad, and sturgeon.

Bay: A body of water partly enclosed by land.

Canal: A man-made waterway, ditch or channel.

Corps of Engineers: Corps of Engineers projects.

Experimental and Research: Request from experimental stations and research laboratories.

Farm Pond Program: Includes all requests for stocking ponds and other still waters on private property under the farm pond program.

Fingerlings: Young fish between one and five inches in length.

Fish and Wildlife: National fish hatcheries, national wildlife refuges, fishery research, or National Aquarium.

Forest Service: National forest areas.

Fry: Recently hatched fish that have reached the free-swimming and feeding stage.

Great Lakes Program: Enhancement and restoration of fish species, such as the lake trout in the Great Lakes.

Hatchery:

Foreign: Distribution to a foreign country.

Local Government: Town, City or County program.

National Fish Hatchery: Transfers between Federal hatcheries.

State: State Fish and Game agency.

Indian Programs: Indian reservations and other areas mandated by treaties of judicial directives.

International Programs: All fish distributed within the United States that are destined for international waters, including species that may not normally range beyond the 200 mile limit.

Impoundment: All man-made lakes of fifty to five hundred acres.

Jurisdiction: Primary responsibility for the fishery program by ownership of water, enabling legislation, cooperative agreement, judicial directive, or other mandate.

Local Government: Waters owned by government bodies below Federal or State level.

Miscellaneous Federal: Waters on Federal agency land not noted on this list.

- National Fish Hatchery:* All transfers between national fish hatcheries.
- National Park Service:* National parks, monuments and recreational areas of the National Park Service.
- Natural Lake:* A permanent naturally occurring still body of water.
- Navy:* Owned or controlled by the Navy, including Marine Corps.
- Pacific Anadromous Program:* Enhancement and restoration of anadromous fish species, such as the Pacific salmon and steelhead trout.
- Private:* Waters on private property under the farm pond or other special program.
- Pond:* A man-made lake under fifty acres.
- Research:* Laboratories, experimental ponds and medical research units.
- Reclamation:* Bureau of Reclamation projects.
- Reservoir:* A man-made lake over five hundred acres.
- State Programs:* State owned or State controlled waters on State or private land.
- Stream:* A natural flowing watercourse other than a tailwater.
- Tailwater:* A stream area below a dam which has normally undergone a drastic habitat change as a consequence of altered conditions.
- Transfer:* Transfers between national fish hatcheries.
- Urban Program:* A summer fishing program created for inner-city and underprivileged citizens.
- Veterans Administration:* Owned or controlled by Veterans Administra-tion.
