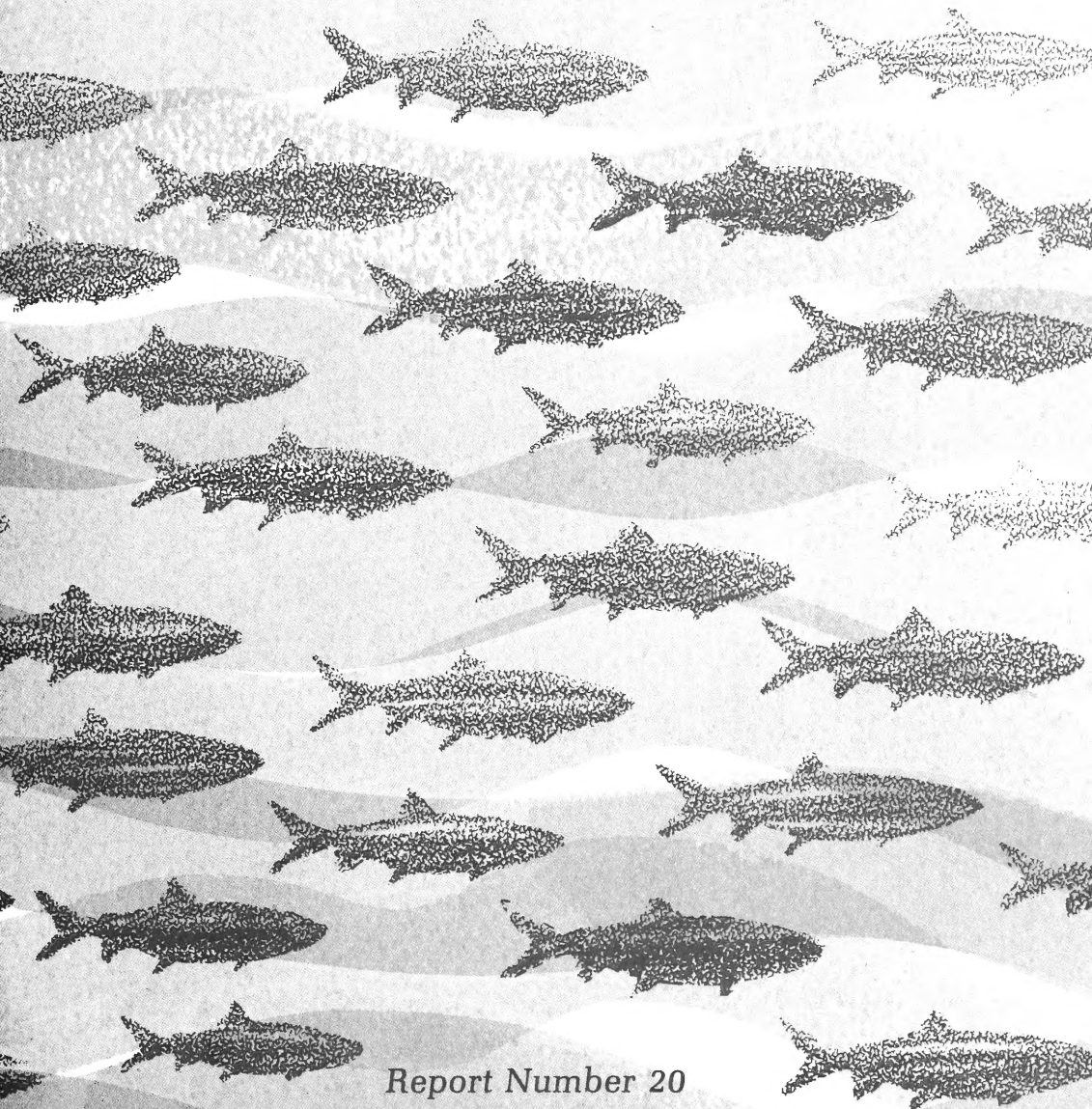

INTRODUCTION

This report on fish and fish eggs distributed by National Fish Hatcheries for the period October 1, 1984, through September 30, 1985, is the 20th in a series of publications issued since 1872. Federal statutory responsibilities for stewardship of the Nation's diverse and valuable fishery resources date from 1871 when Congress established the position of Commissioner of Fish and Fisheries in response to concerns about the decline in domestic food fish supplies. The tables provide a compilation of hatcheries, species, and program distribution data that describe the Fish and Wildlife Service's activities in fulfilling Federal stewardship responsibilities for fishery resources. Currently, the Service's fish production activities are being evaluated and redirected to fully support the responsibilities and role of the Service in fishery resources.

During its early years, the National Fish Hatchery System was the principal, often the only, management tool available for addressing fishery resource problems. However, changing resource needs, evolving management philosophies, growth of the science and technology of fishery management, the development of State capabilities, and legislative direction have significantly altered the role of National Fish Hatcheries in addressing fishery resource problems. While fish culture capabilities were used in the past, mainly to enhance stocks, facilitating restoration and scientific management of self-sustaining fish populations and mitigating fish losses are now major responsibilities of the Service's Fishery Resources Program. In the 1980's, moreover, the Service has become an increasingly active partner with the States, tribes, and foreign governments in the management of interjurisdictional fishery resources.

Changing circumstances warranted reevaluation of the responsibilities and role of the Service's Fishery Resources Program with regard to State and tribal responsibilities in the management of the Nation's fishery resources. This process identified four areas that represent the responsibilities of the Service's Fishery Resources Program. It should be recognized that these responsibilities are not exclusively those of the Service. Close cooperation is mandatory with States, tribes, and other Federal agencies that are concerned with and share in the management of these resources.

Specifically, the Service's Fishery Resources Program focusses its efforts to:

- o facilitate restoration of depleted, nationally significant fishery resources,

- seek and provide for mitigation of fishery resource impairment due to Federal water-related development,
- assist with the management of fishery resources on Federal (primarily Service) and Indian lands, and
- maintain a Federal leadership role in scientifically-based management of national fishery resources.

To address these responsibilities, the Fish and Wildlife Service operates 93 production and support facilities comprising the National Fish Hatchery System, (see pages 65 thru 71). These facilities involve fish production, distribution, fish health, fish passage, and fish technology. Additional support is provided through the Service's fishery assistance offices, (see pages 72 thru 73), whose role is to determine fishery management needs, prepare fishery management plans, participate in and/or monitor plan implementation and evaluate the effectiveness of fish hatchery products. This technical assistance is provided to the Service's National Wildlife Refuges, military installations, Indian reservations, and other Federal agencies.

The fish production component of the National Fish Hatchery System is comprised of 73 fish production and distribution facilities and 3 fish production and technology facilities. Of the 73 production and distribution facilities, 17 are involved in the Pacific anadromous program, 5 in lake trout, 7 in Atlantic salmon, and 3 in endangered species. Twenty stations are involved in coldwater species and 21 in warmwater species. Fish production at the 3 production and technology facilities is divided among Pacific anadromous, Atlantic salmon, lake trout, rainbow trout, and several warmwater species.

The support component of the National Fish Hatchery System is comprised of 10 fish health centers and offices, 2 fish passage facilities, and 5 fish technology centers (including the 3 production facilities). The fish health centers and offices provide the expertise required for the diagnosis and treatment of fish diseases and regular disease certification of production facilities. The fish passage facilities provide for upstream passage of adults to maintain spawning activity. The technology centers, as the name implies, provide the technological expertise necessary for direct operational support of fish production at National Fish Hatcheries. Application of research findings greatly enhance fish production at the hatcheries. In support of the Fishery Resources Program, the Service's Research and Development Program identifies and develops basic information for the enhancement of fish husbandry.

The fish and fish egg distribution presented in this booklet represents the combined efforts of the Service's production and support facilities. Some of the data presented reflects the beginning of the transition that is required for the Fishery Resources Program to meet its new responsibilities in a most effective and efficient manner.

GLOSSARY

ADULT - Fish that have attained sexual maturity.

ANADROMOUS FISH - A marine fish such as Pacific or Atlantic Salmon, Striped Bass, and Steelhead Trout that migrate upstream into fresh-water to spawn.

ATLANTIC ANADROMOUS PROGRAM - Restoration of anadromous fish species, such as Atlantic Salmon, Striped Bass, and Sturgeon.

COLDWATER SPECIES - Generally, fish that spawn in water temperatures below 55° F. The main cultural species are Trout and Salmon.

COOLWATER SPECIES - Generally, fish that spawn in temperatures between 40° and 60° F. Main cultural cool-water species are Northern Pike, Muskellunge, Walleye, Sauger, and Yellow Perch.

ENDANGERED SPECIES - Species of fish listed as either endangered or threatened under the U. S. Endangered Species Act of May 1977.

FINGERLING - Young fish between one and five inches in length. (For purposes of this Report, all Parr and some Smolts are included within the Fingerling Column.)

FRY - Recently hatched fish that have reached the free-swimming and feeding stage.

GREAT LAKES PROGRAM - Restoration of Lake Trout stocks in the Great Lakes.

IMPOUNDMENT - All man-made lakes of fifty to five hundred acres.

JURISDICTION - Primary responsibility for fisheries by Ownership of Water, Enabling Legislation, Cooperative Agreement, Judicial Directive, or other Mandate.

PACIFIC ANADROMOUS PROGRAM - Mitigation and restoration of anadromous fish species, such as Chinook, Coho and Chum Salmon, and Steelhead Trout.

PARR - A Life stage of Salmonid Fish extending from time feeding begins until fish become sufficiently pigmented to obliterate the Parr marks, usually ending during the first year.

RESEARCH - Laboratories, experimental ponds and medical research units.

RESERVOIR - A man-made lake over five hundred acres.

TRANSFER - The shipment of fish between National Fish Hatcheries.

SMOLT - Juvenile Salmonid at the time of physiological adaptation to life in the marine environment.

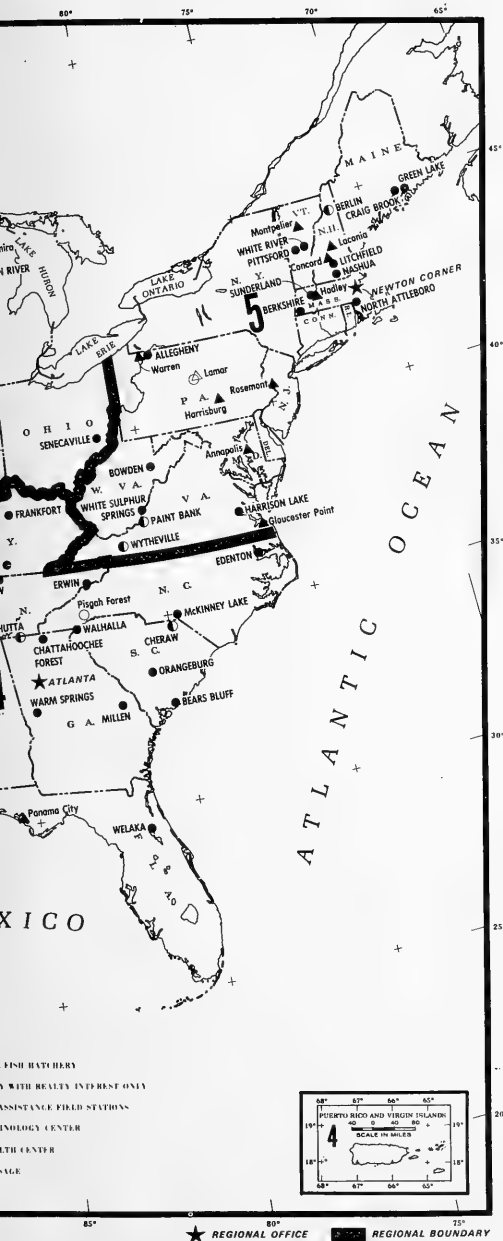

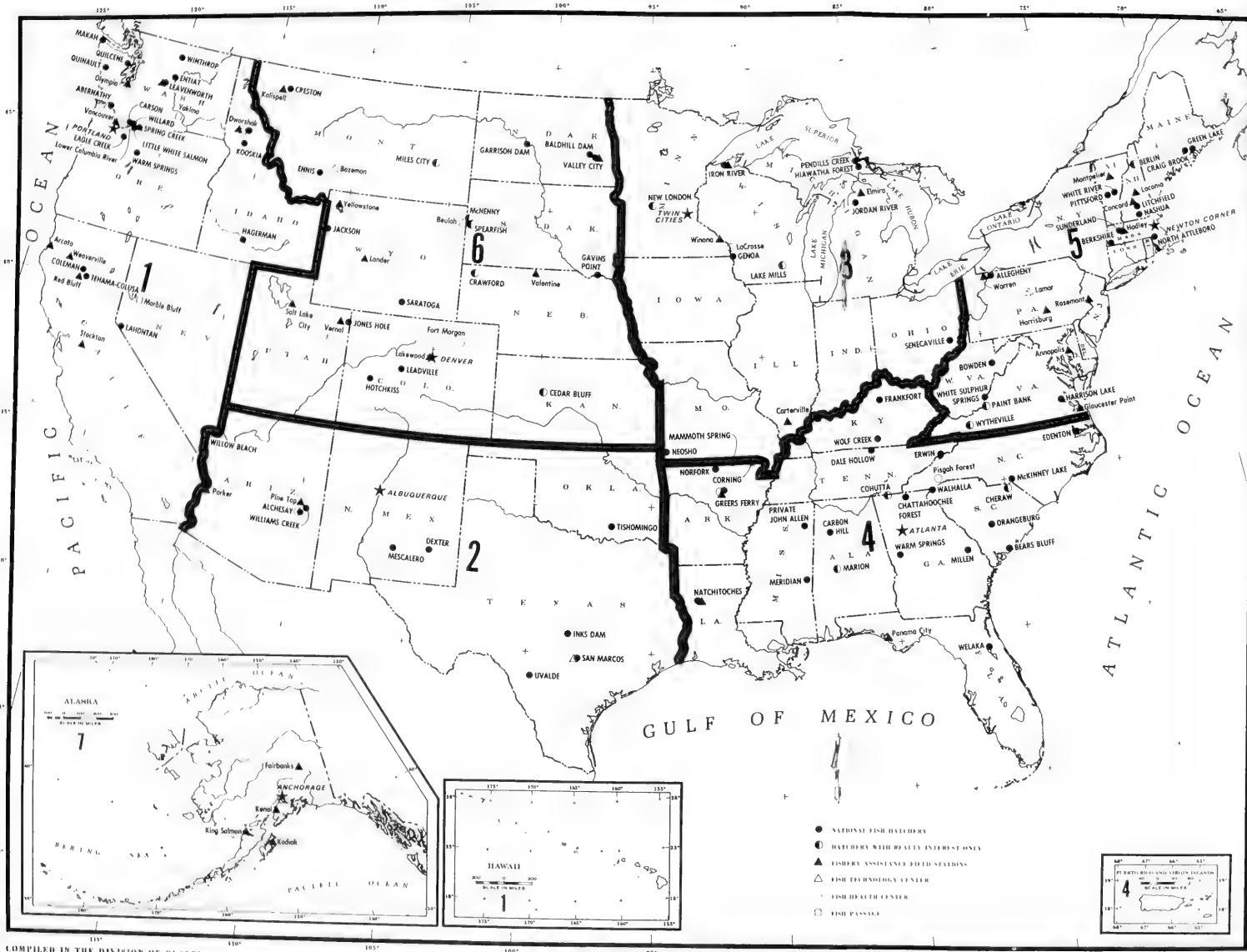
