


#### PUBLIC NOTICE

Mr. Raymond E. Beale, Jr., Hingham Executive Park Trust, 1 Accord Pond Drive, Hingham, Massachusetts 02043

has requested a Corps of Engineers permit under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act to place fill in a wetland off Abington Street in Hingham, Massachusetts directly along the Hingham/Rockland town line, as shown on the attached plans, to provide access for the proposed development of a 56.4 acre upland site into a five lot executive office park. Specifically, the work entails a 700' long roadway crossing of a wetland that is co-dominated by Atlantic white cedar, eastern hemlock and cherry birch. The proposed roadway is 35' wide with an additional 7.5' of off-grading on either side. The total wetland area impacted is 35,000 s.f. and occurs totally within a 50' wide right of way which was established by the Massachusetts Department of Public Works as an Order of Taking by the State of Massachusetts for the construction of State Route 3 dated January 5, 1960. No other work in wetlands is proposed. 48,048 s.f. compensatory cedar bog is proposed within detention area "A" in what is now an upland area.

In order to properly evaluate the proposal, we are seeking public comment. Anyone wishing to comment is encouraged to do so. Comments should be submitted in writing by September 14, 1987. Any person may request, in writing, within the comment period specified in this notice, that a public hearing be held to consider the application. Requests for a public hearing shall specifically state the reasons for holding a public hearing. The Corps holds public hearings for the purpose of obtaining public comments, when that is the best means for understanding a wide variety of concerns from a diverse segment of the public.

The decision whether to issue a permit will be based on an evaluation of the probable impact of the proposed activity on the public interest. That decision will reflect the national concern for both protection and utilization of important resources. The benefit which reasonably may be expected to accrue from the proposal must be balanced against its reasonably foreseeable detriments. All factors which may be relevant to the proposal will be considered including the cumulative effects thereof; among those are conservation, economics, aesthetics, general environmental concerns, wetlands, cultural values, fish and wildlife values, flood hazards, flood plain values, laod use, navigation, shoreline erosion and accretion, recreation, water supply and conservation, water quality, energy needs, safety, food production and, in general, the needs and welfare of the people.

Where the activity involves the discharge of dredged or fill material into waters of the United States or the transportation of dredged material for the purpose of disposing of it is ocean waters. The evaluation of the impact of the activity on the public interest will also include application of the guidelines promulgated by the Administrator, U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, under authority of Section 404(b) of the Clean Water Act, and/or Section 102(a) of the Marine Protection Research and Sanctuaries Act of 1972 as amended.

Based on his initial review, the Division Engineer has determined that little likelihood exists for the proposed work to impinge upon properties listed in or eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places and no further consideration of the requirements of the Preservation of Historical and Archaeological Data Aod of 1974 is necessary. This determination is based on one or more of the following:

- a. The permit area has been extensively modified by previous work.
- b. The permit area has been recently created.
- c. The proposed activity is of limited nature and scope.
- d. Review of the latest published version of the National Register shows that no presence of registered properties or properties listed as being eligible for inclusion therein are in the permit area or general vicinity.

Presently unknown archeological, scientific, pre-historic or historical data may be lost or destroyed by work to be accomplished under the requested permit.

The Division Engineer has also consulted the latest published list of threatened or endangered species and has made a preliminary determination that the proposed activity will not affect those species listed or their critical habitat.

The initial determinations made herein will be reviewed in light of facts submitted in response to this notice.

The following authorizations have been applied for or have been or will be obtained:

- (X) Permit, License or Assent from State.
- (X) Permit from Local Wetlands Agency or Conservation Commission.
- (X) Water Quality Certification in accordance with Section 401 of the Clean Water Act.


The States of Connecticut, Maine, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, and Rhode Island have approved Coastal Zone Management Programs. Where applicable, the applicant states that the proposed activity complies with and will be conducted in a manner that is consistent with this approved Coastal Zone Management Program. Issuance of a State permit from the appropriate State agency will indicate concurrence with this Statement of Consistency.

All comments will be considered a matter of public record. Copies of letters of objection will be forwarded to the applicant who will normally be requested to contact objectors directly in an effort to reach an understanding.






SCHEMATIC






SOUTH SHORE INDUSTRIAL PARK TRUST































## TYPICAL ROADWAY CROSS SECTION - 50' Right of Way




TYPICAL SECTION THROUGH CONC. RETAINING WALL


CULVERT STA 6 + 33 I" = 10' HORIZ. I" = 4' VERT.


CULVERT STA 9 + 00 I" = 10' HORIZ. I" = 4' VERT.


CULVERT STA 11+60 I" = 10' HORIZ. I" = 4' VERT.
