Bob Williams has mastered the French language. He is now a professor at a leading college.

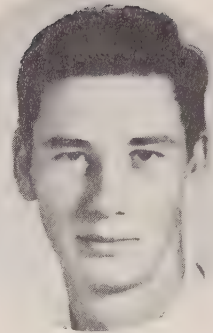
