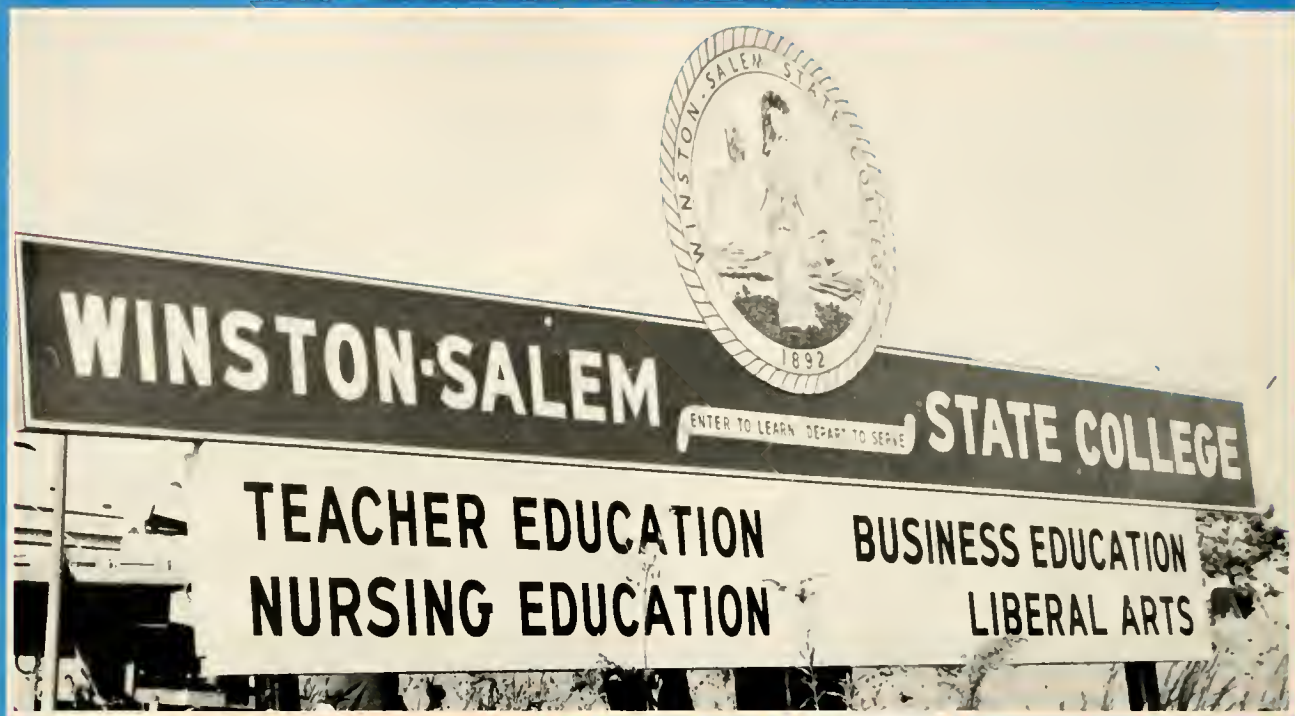

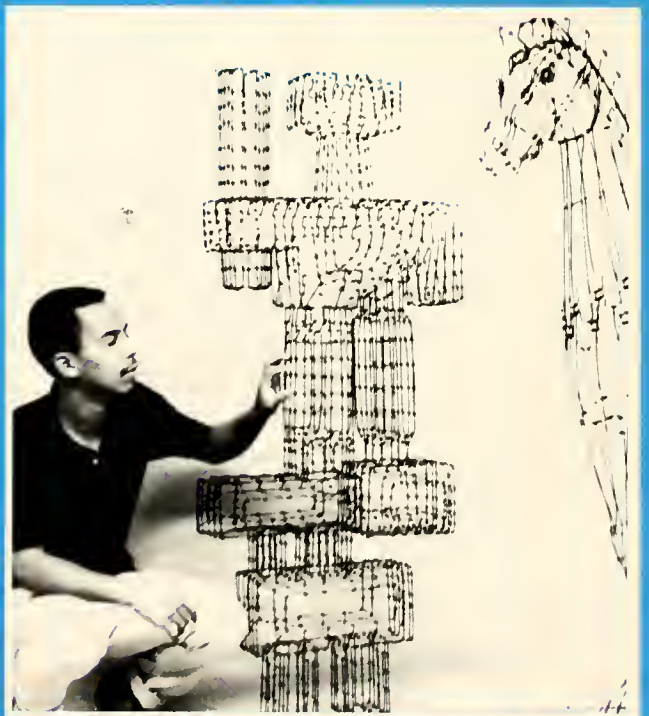

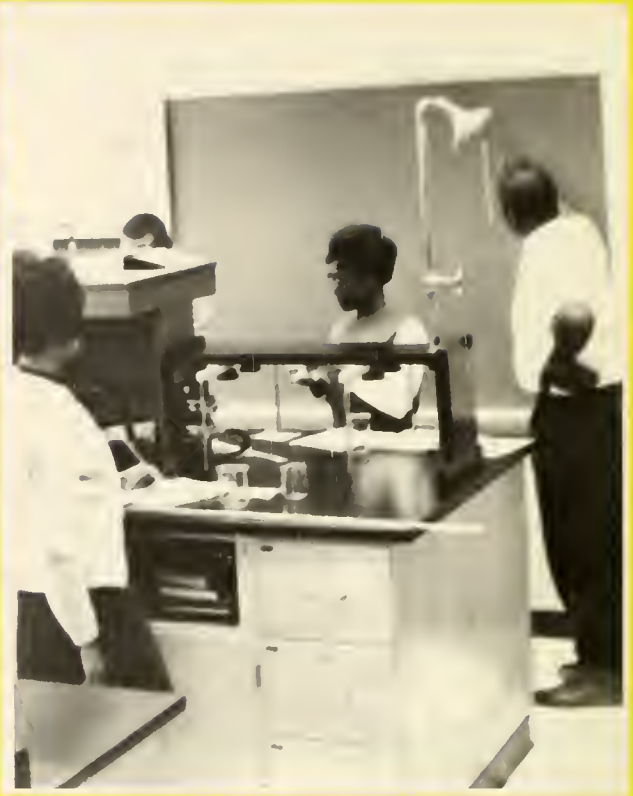

HOLY SONNET

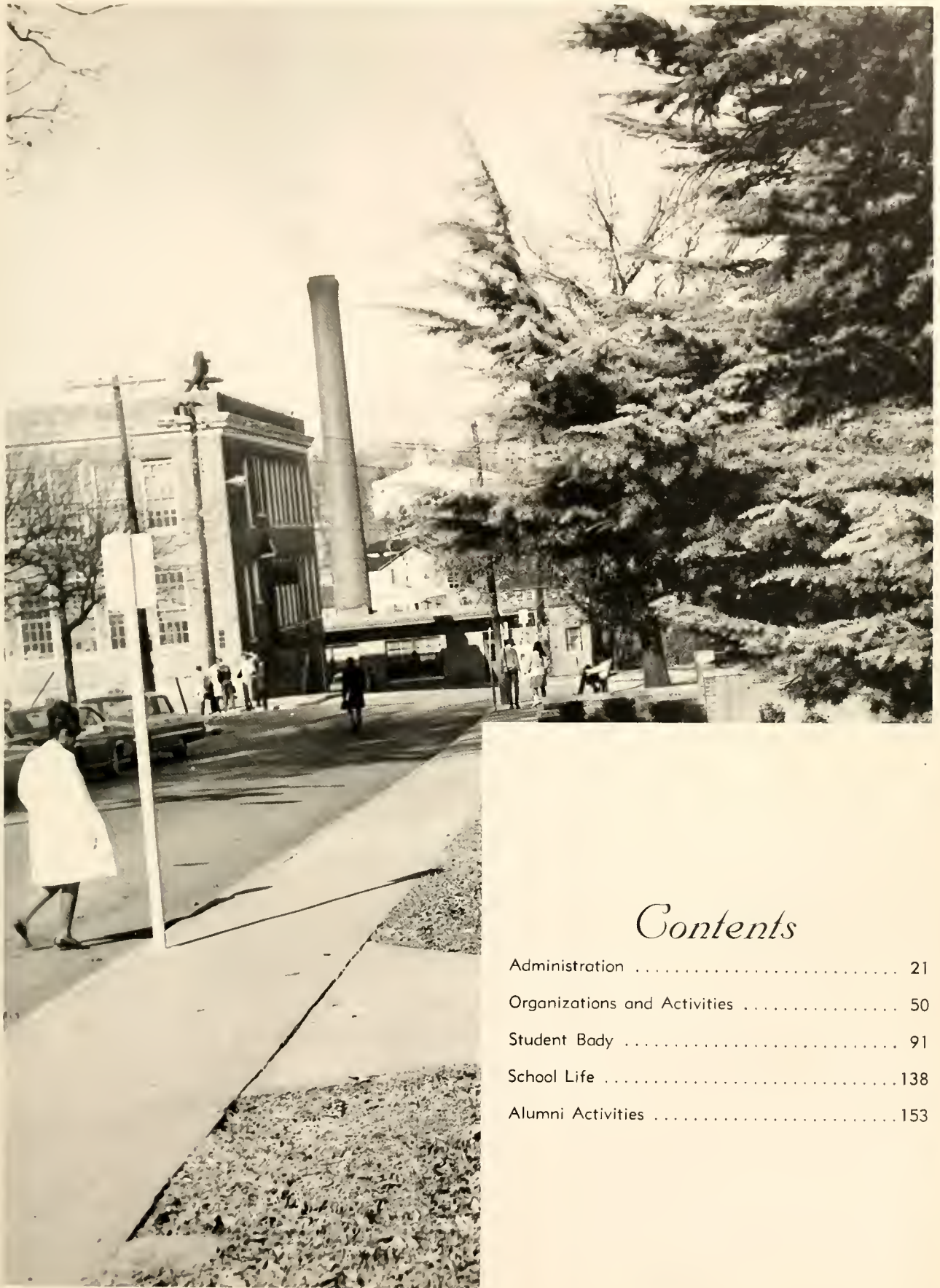
Death, be not proud, though some have called thee

J. S. HILL HALL

J. S. Hill Hall was completed in August, 1965, and is not yet fully equipped. It is a three-story brick and steel structure containing an area of approximately 35,000 square feet.

The first floor is designed for instruction in physics and the physical sciences. In addition, there are a special projects laboratory, a darkroom, a mimeograph room, and three faculty offices. In the west wing, the lecture hall, with a seating capacity for 156 students, is air-conditioned and equipped for movie projection.

The second floor is designed primarily for instruction in the biological sciences. There are two general biology laboratories with facilities for 36 students each, a comparative anatomy laboratory with a capacity for 16 students, a microbiology laboratory with facilities for 24 students, a botany laboratory, an advanced biology

laboratory, a classroom seating 39 students, and four faculty offices.

The third floor is designed and equipped for instruction in chemistry. There are two general chemistry laboratories with facilities for 32 students and four faculty offices. There is one organic chemistry laboratory with facilities for 24 students, one physical chemistry laboratory with facilities for 16 students, one advanced chemistry laboratory with facilities for 16 students.

On the roof is space designed for astronomical observation.

Architects for the structure were Lashmit, Brown, and Pollock. The general contractor was Fowler-Jones Construction Company.



C. BEATRICE MOORE HALL

C. Beatrice Moore Hall was completed in June, 1963. It is a four story brick and steel structure containing an area of approximately 19,350 sq. ft. The four stories consist of a ground floor, a main entrance level, and second and third floors. Each floor has a laundry room, a central bath facility, and access to an incinerator.

The ground floor contains a recreation room which opens on a patio, a kitchen area, and a large area for trunk storage.

The main floor has a living room, an apartment for the dormitory director, and an office.

The building has sixty bedrooms with capacity for 120 students. Each of the bedrooms has permanently installed furniture which consists of two beds, two study desks, swivel wall lights and ceiling lights.

The architects were Loshmit, Brown, and Pollock. The general contractor was the Gollimore Construction Company.

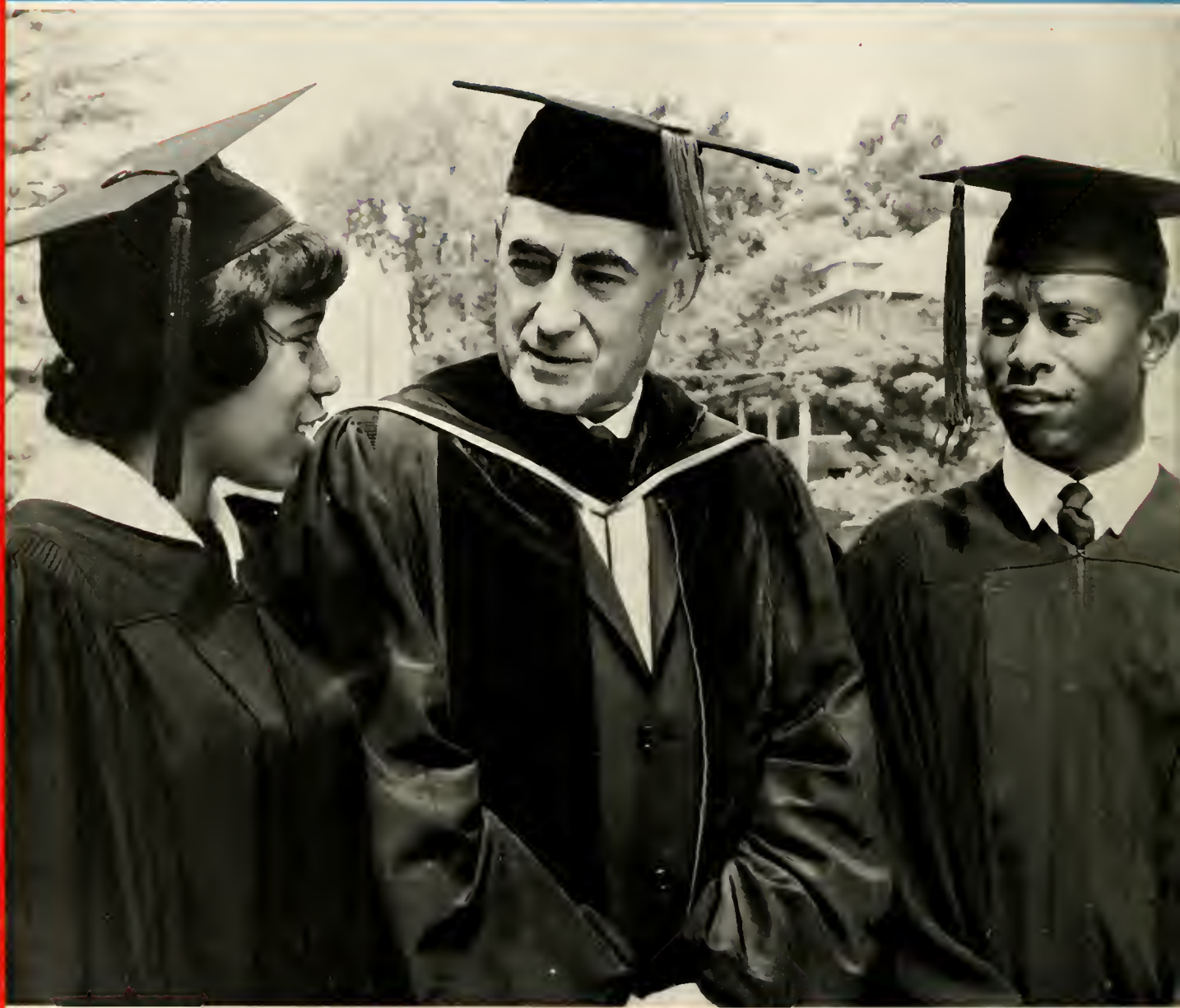
