permission

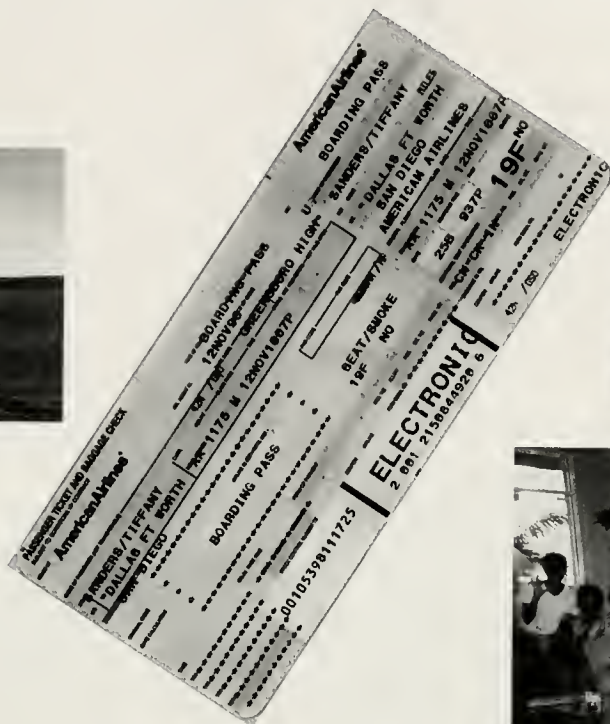

*Dear Diary,*

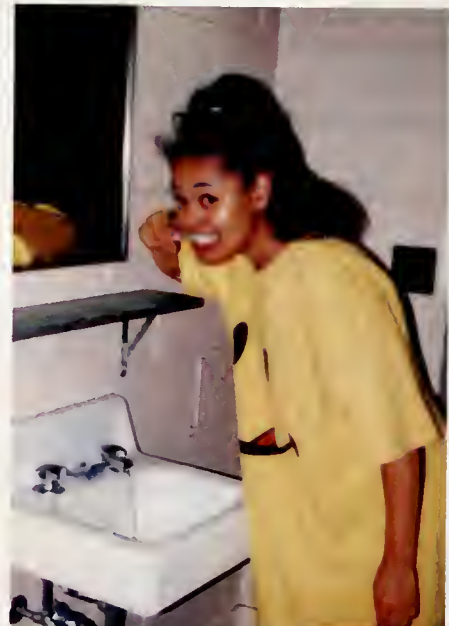
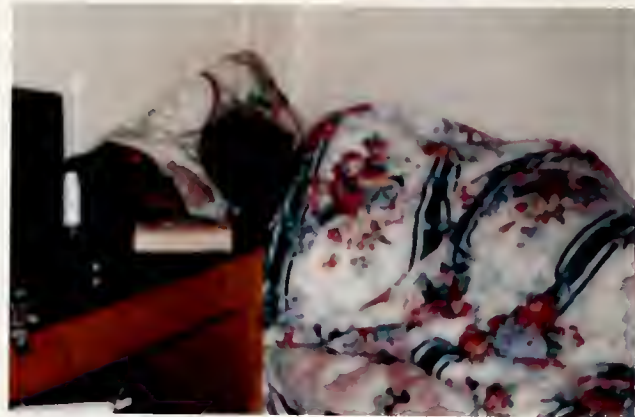
*It's me again the professional student. I know it's been a while since my last entry, but I've been busy trying to finish my english paper that was due on last friday.*

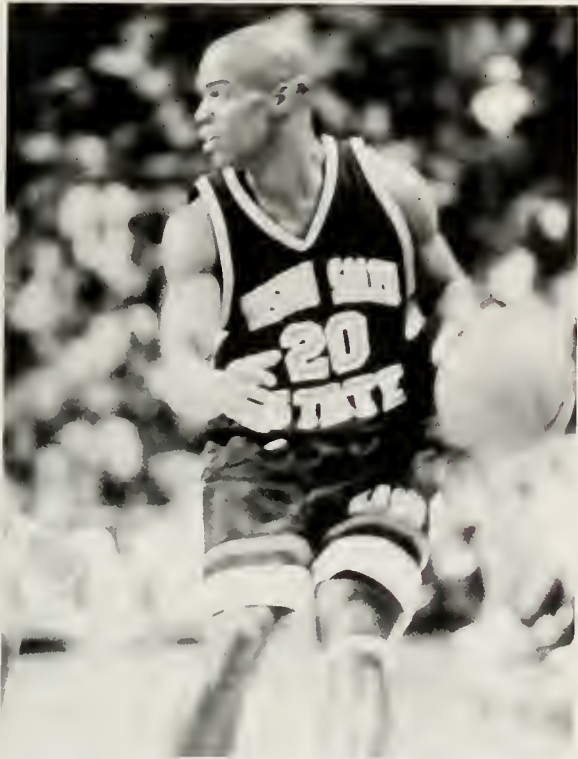
## The 54th Annual CIAA Tournament!!
