C. E. "BIGHOUSE" GAINES: COACH, PROFESSOR, FATHER, HUMANITARIAN-- LEGEND

While a student at Morgan State College, Clarence "Bighouse" Gaines acquired the name "Bighouse" when another football player, himself a mere 250 pounds, exclaimed in awe, "Anybody bigger'n me must be big as a house, so I'm callin' you 'Bighouse'". Gaines graduated from Morgan State with two All-America scrolls and a degree in chemistry that will help him in pursuing a career in dentistry. Instead, he has become one of the most illustrious figures in the sport of basketball.

Gaines' achievements as a basketball coach have earned him a place in many halls of fame. His accomplishments as a human being have earned him respect and admiration of all those who know him- personally and by reputation.

His idealism was nurtured by his family in his hometown of Paduchah, Kentucky. His mother, herself a star basketball player in high school, instilled in him the idea that winning was the norm: "I used to tell him," she recalled, "'We never lost a basketball game when I played... How do you feel when you lose?'" Under her guidance, the young Clarence excelled in both football and basketball.

Olivia and Lester Gaines, never had a chance to get a strong, formal education, but that only made them more determined to provide only the best educational opportunities for their only child, Clarence Edward. Because his parents worked - Gaines as a hotel chef and Mrs. Gaines as a resident domestic worker- young Gaines was reared by his grandmother, Mrs. Ida Bolen. She helped to instill in the youngster rigid principles of self-discipline and independence.

By the time Clarence Gaines entered Lincoln Consolidated School, the influence of his parents and grandmother was evident. He distinguished himself as one of the school's better students while displaying a penchant for a variety of subjects.

Gaines began to display a strong interest in organized sports in junior high school. As a former high school and community all-star athlete, his mother appreciated the value of sports activities, but she made sure Clarence developed his other talents. "Not only did Clarence excel in his studies, he had a natural talent in drama and music. He was an outstanding drama student and a member of the concert band, playing both the piano and the clarinet."

Following his very successful matriculation at Lincoln Consolidated School- including starring in football and basketball - the time approached for Gaines to select a college. He was accepted for admission by Howard University, Lincoln University and Morgan State College.



Not only do I consider it fit for a coach to follow his chosen career, but he should also be a teacher and leader in other fields. He should exemplify those traits which deal with character building.

His first choice was Howard. After arriving there, he was informed that Harry Payne -head football coach and the man for whom Gaines had hoped to play- had been fired. Gaines and Payne had a long discussion about what Gaines should do. Payne advised him to go to Morgan State.

After completing his work at Morgan State, Gaines was prepared to begin his professional career. He found his way to Winston-Salem State University -then Teachers College. Gaines was hired to teach mathematics and health and physical education. At the beginning of his second year he inherited the entire Health and Physical Education Department and athletic program. In fact, he was virtually the whole program, coaching football, tennis, boxing and basketball for men and women, in addition to his teaching duties and serving as athletic director.



"Bighouse" Gaines Week in Winston-Salem and North Carolina, respectively. An appreciation banquet attracted nearly 1,000 University friends. The gathering was highlighted by the establishment of the C.E. Gaines Athletic Scholarship Fund and an initial contribution of \$5,000 by Coca-Cola USA.

Though Gaines is thoroughly committed to his many roles at Winston-Salem State University, he has never neglected his civic responsibilities. With the support and assistance of Lester Ervin, current fire chief of Winston-Salem, and Larry Williams, a radio broadcaster known throughout North Carolina, Gaines organized the first Little League baseball program in Winston-Salem. He also provided the coaches and was very instrumental in raising funds to support the program.

In 1965, he organized North Carolina's first resident basketball camp for blacks. His list of accomplishments includes work on scores of committees, and numerous efforts to help people of all ages. Always a concerned citizen, he has assumed a variety of responsible activities in the

Overcoming the recruiting handicaps created by the college's limited curriculum and lack of financial resources, the young coach quickly built winning programs in a variety of sports. Between 1947 and 1982, his basketball teams experienced only two losing seasons, and Coach Gaines recorded more wins than any other active college coach in the United States.

Because of his unparalleled accomplishments and his unwavering commitment to Winston-Salem State, the University named its new athletic facility in his honor -the C.E. Gaines Center. The building was dedicated during the Founder's Day observance in October, 1980, and the University family presented a portrait to grace one of its walls.

In 1982, the University spearheaded a community-wide effort to celebrate Gaines' election to the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. Mayor Wayne Corpening and Governor James Hunt declared May 3-7,



community.

Because of his outstanding humanitarian service, three awards have been established in Coach Gaines' name: Hanes Hosiery Corporation's CIAA Outstanding Player of the Year, the Winston-Salem Sportsmen Club's C.E. Gaines Athletic Award and St. Paul Methodist Church's C.E. Gaines Athletic Award. The extent of the coach's service to the area is summed up in a letter from Mayor Wayne A. Corpening: "During the... years 'Bighouse' has lived in Winston-Salem, his community service has become legendary among his fellow citizens. He has given and continues to give without thought of reward."

The 2001 Ram staff is pleased to dedicate this publication to "Bighouse" Gaines for all of his contributions to the Winston-Salem State family and community.
