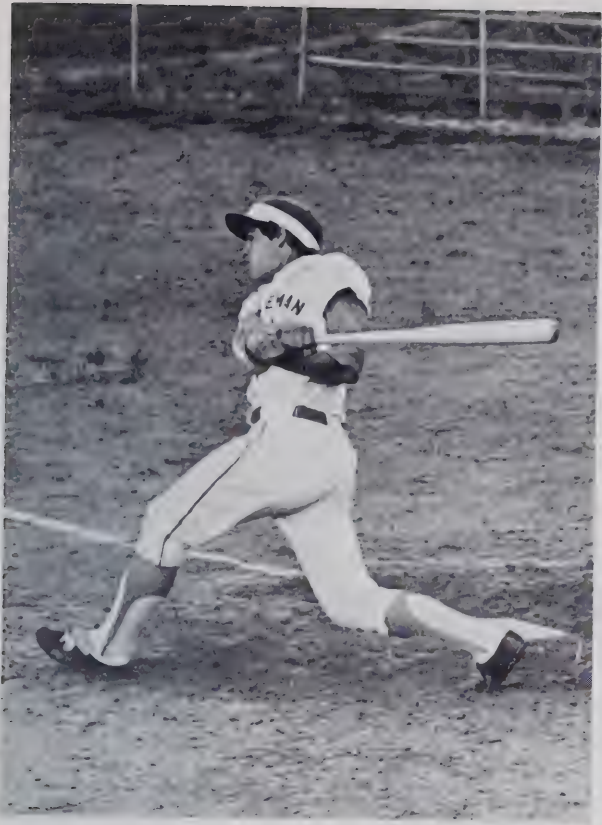
Baseball embraces something that is fundamental to life, human competition, the strength and resourcefulness of one man with a bat against another man with a ball.
