ANNOUNCEMENT.

In presenting our Trade List for the Fall of 1872, we beg to state that our stock in all departments is better than common, and especially of the following articles:

STANDARD PEAR TREES, EXTRA SIZE, FIRST CLASS AND COMMON SIZE, FIRST AND SECOND CLASS ONE YEAR OLD, PEAR SEEDLINGS, ONE YEAR OLD APPLE TREES, CURRANTS ONE AND TWO YEARS OLD, WHITE GRAPE, CHERRY, &c.

Digging—We claim to dig our trees better than is common, using large steel digging spade, made to order. We shall probably commence taking up trees for the fall trade, about the first of October.

Dozen rates will be charged, when less than 50 trees are ordered; 100 rates for less than 500; over 500, 1000 rates. All orders are packed in the best possible manner, for which a charge will be made to cover the cost of material only.

All packages at purchasers' risk after shipment.

All orders should be made on a separate sheet of paper. When shipping directions are not given, we ship according to the best of our knowledge.

Our Terms are Cash, or satisfactory bank note at 60 days.

Our location for growing and shipping trees, is surpassed by none in America; our business has been established since 1839.

In filling orders at these prices, the selections of varieties must be left partly to us.
