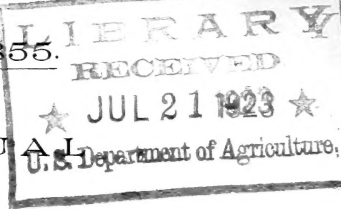

NOTICE.


IN again offering our stock in this, our Semi-Annual Price List, to the trade in general, we take pleasure in acknowledging the liberal patronage hitherto extended to us, and hope, by the same careful packing and prompt filling of all orders with which we are favored, to retain the same and add many new purchasers, this fall, of our large stock offered at low rates. Having nothing but young, healthy stock, to which all the new, desirable varieties have been added in the past three years, we confidently expect to give satisfaction to all who may intrust their orders to us. Our central position affords us unequalled facility for cheap freights and shipping.

We usually commence shipping about the 20th of September and continue until January. In Spring, from March through May, but can often ship south during entire month of February.

Selection of varieties must be in part left to us, but the wishes of customers will be consulted as far as possible.

At the prices named, 50 will be furnished at the 100 rate, and 500 at the 1,000 rate.

Plain and particular directions should be given how the packages are to be marked, and by what route sent. When left to us we will use our best judgment.

 *No responsibility will be assumed by us after proper shipment.*

Claims for allowance must be made immediately upon receipt of goods.

Our Fall business must all be done in a few weeks. It is a great convenience to us, we are able to do better by our customers, when orders are sent to us before the busy season begins, *and we will consider it a great favor if you will order early.*

PACKING.

When dealers pack with us we heel in their entire stock by itself, and furnish labels and tying material free. Boxes and packing charged as follows: 8 feet long, 28x28 inches, \$2.50; 24x24 inches, \$2.25; 20x20 inches, \$1.75; 16x16 inches, \$1.50; 12x12 inches, \$1.00. For second-hand boxes, 50 cents will be deducted from the three larger sizes, and 25 cents from each of the three smaller sizes. Bales, 25 cents to \$2.00, according to size. No charge is made for drayage from nursery to railroad station.

TERMS.

5 per cent discount for cash *with order*—no discount allowed unless cash reaches us before shipment.

OUR TERMS ARE CASH, or Bankable Note on short time. When credit is given it must be by special agreement. All over-due accounts will be subject to draft at sight.

If currency is sent by express, the package should be prepaid.
