TERMS, ETC.

Orders to the amount of \$10 may be made out at hundred rates, where not less than six of a kind are wanted. Our regular rates for general orders are six at dozen, 25 at 100, 500 at 1000. Orders to the amount of \$30, accompanied with cash, will be entitled to a discount of five per cent. No discount unless cash is received before shipment.

Unknown correspondents must remit with orders or give satisfactory references, otherwise goods will be shipped C. O. D. Remittance must be made by New York or Chicago drafts, post-office orders on Aurora, registered letters, or by express. Money sent in unregistered letters at sender's risk. Individual drafts subject to discount for collection. Parties remitting currency from Canada will please procure United States money, as their currency is discounted 6 per cent. by our banks. All claims for reduction must be made on receip. 2f goods.

SHIPPING.

All goods sent by express unless otherwise ordered. Goods by freight entirely at furchaser's risk. Small orders may be sent by mail; if plants are so ordered, 75 cents per 100, or \$6 per 1000 must be added to the price of plants to pay postage.

All plants removed from pots and the balls of earth carefully wrapped in paper before shipping. If ordered in pots, cost of pots and extra cost of packing will be added.

We ship plants at all seasons of the year and guarantee safe arrival if shipped by express. No retail list issued this season.
