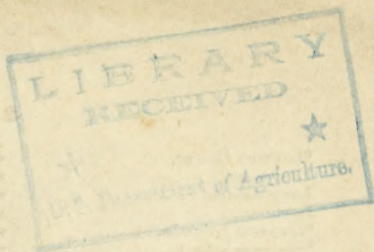

All the Roses rated at 75 cts. or over, are reduced 30 per cent, with the exception of the Moss and Tree or Standard Roses. The Moss Roses priced at \$1.75 and over, are reduced 25 per cent.

A selection may be made from any publication, or Catalogue of any respectable Nursery, with prices, and we will furnish all the varieties at least as low or lower than any one else, and our great stock enables us to send larger sized plants than are usually sold.

Those who desire a large number of Roses for re-vending, will be supplied by the hundred, at very reduced rates.

Tree or Standard Roses have proved a failure, and but few are found to flourish, as our powerful sun proves destructive to them.

NOTE.—Amateurs of Roses would do well to visit the different establishments that have published extensive Catalogues of Roses, as many of them have not half as many plants, all told, as the number of names they enumerate, and several of them have none at all.
