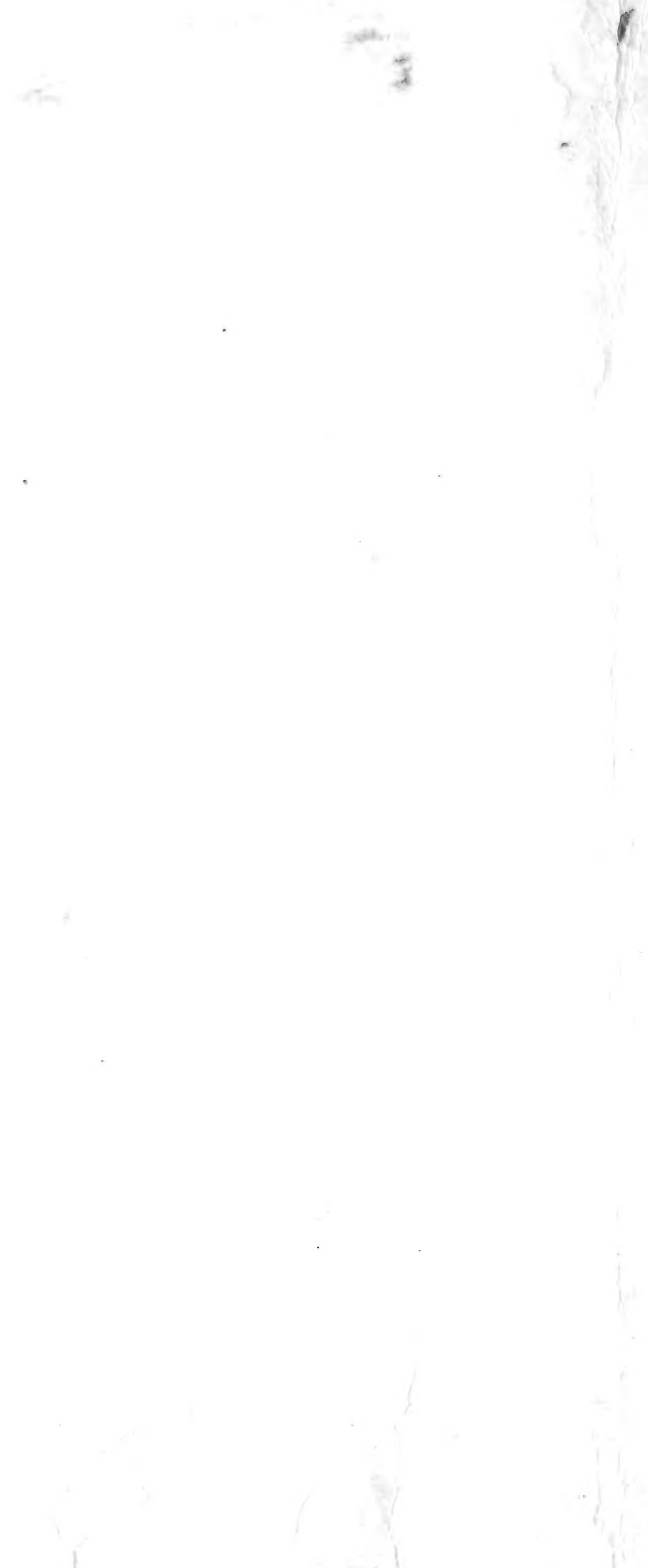

## FIELD GROWN

### RARE VARIETIES

- 120 **Madam Edouard Herriott**—(Pernetiana.) A unique blending of shrimp pink, copper, orange and apricot.  
50 **Willowmere**—(Pernetiana.) Flowers large, shrimp pink, turning yellow in center, edges carmine pink.

### NEWEST IN ROSES

- 120 **Chateau de Clos Vougeot**—(H. T.) Deep velvety scarlet shaded to bright red.  
40 **Erna Teschendorff**—(Dwarf Poly.) Color a brilliant carmine red, similar to Gruss an Teplitz.  
40 **Excelsa**—(H. Wich.) Flowers double, bright scarlet, produced in clusters.  
20 **Edward Mawley**—(H. T.) Dark velvety crimson, almost continuously in bloom.  
100 **Farben-Konigin**—(H. T.) Carmine rose, somewhat deeper color on the outside of petals.  
200 **Heinrich Munch**—(H. P.) Pink. It has every characteristic of Druschki, except in color.  
20 **Helvetia**—(H. T.) Fine cut flower rose; inside of petals bright pink, outside fiery red.  
30 **Herzogin Marie Antoinette**—(H. T.) One of the finest of the yellow roses; buds long, orange gold.  
80 **Hiawatha**—(H. Wich.) Flowers rich carmine with white center.  
20 **Jonkheer J. L. Mock**—(H. T.) In color, it is a mixture of bright red and salmon pink.  
160 **Juliet**—(Hybrid Briar.) Outside of petals old gold; interior rosy red, changing deep rose.  
30 **Konigin Carola**—(H. T.) Satiny rose with reverse of petals silvery rose.  
70 **Laurent Carle**—(H. T.) Brilliant velvety carmine; flowers very large, of perfect form.  
40 **Lieutenant Chaure**—(H. T.) Velvety crimson shaded garnet.  
70 **Lady Ashtown**—(H. T.) Pale rose shading to yellow at base of petals; reflex of petals silvery pink.  
200 **Lady Hillingdon**—(T.) Orange yellow.  
30 **Leuchtfeuer**—(Bengal.) Blood red.  
140 **Madam Jule Grolez**—(H. T.) Satiny China rose.  
250 **Rayon d'Or**—(H. T.) Coppery orange.
