The hardy sorts cannot be dug in mid-winter and to insure their delivery much before May 1st., they should be engaged this fall when they will be taken up and stored away in mud in our greenhouses and shipped as ordered. Parties not knowing exactly how many they will need should state the probable quantity of each and we will allow slight changes in the order at any time before shipment.

Terms; 30 days from date of delivery, with satisfactory reference from unknown parties; all accounts due July 1st. Five per cent discount for cash with order.
