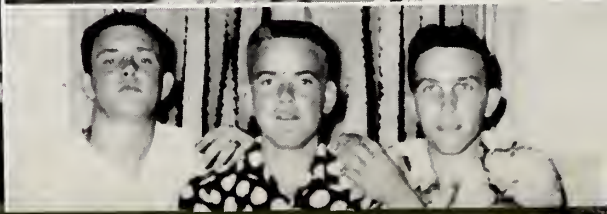
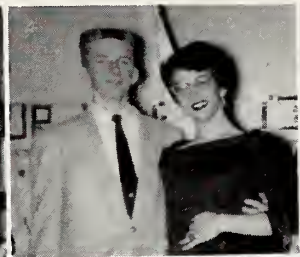
The Pantherettes played nine games this season, winning three, losing four, and tying one. They practiced and played hard, and enjoyed their season.
