but a rose cannot grow alone.



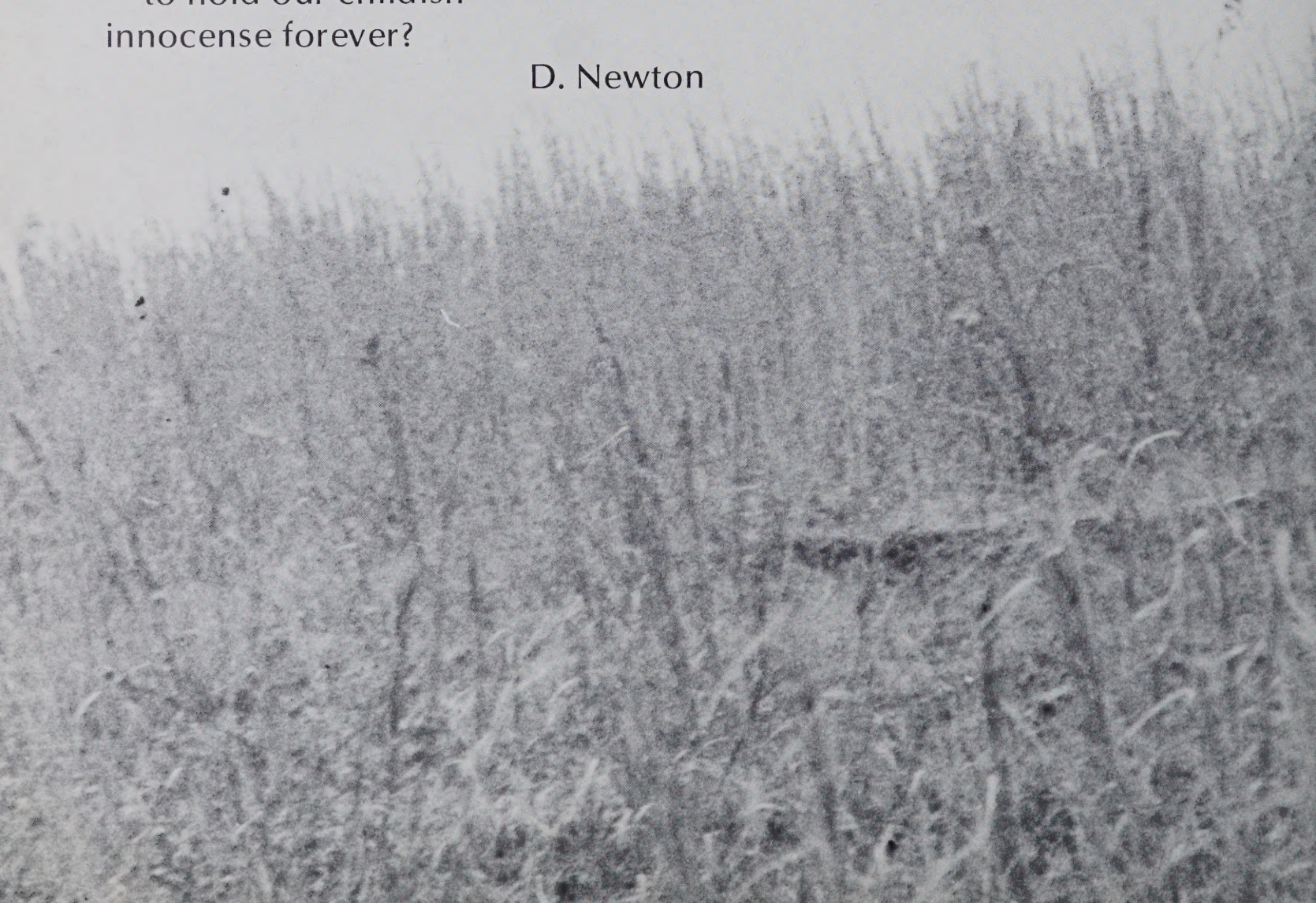

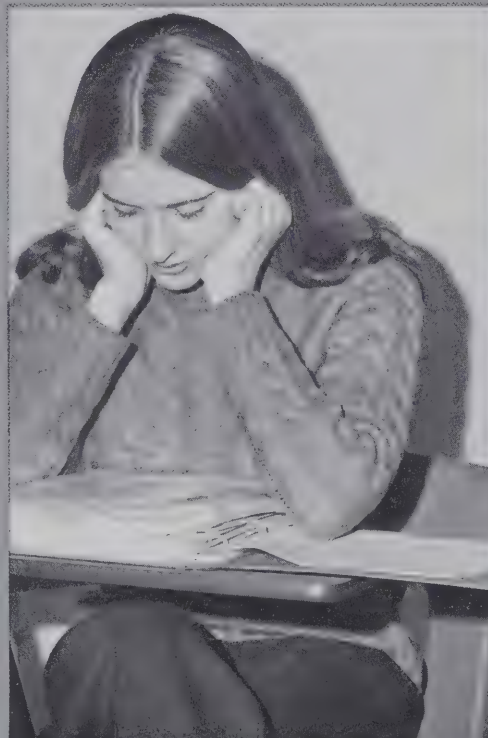
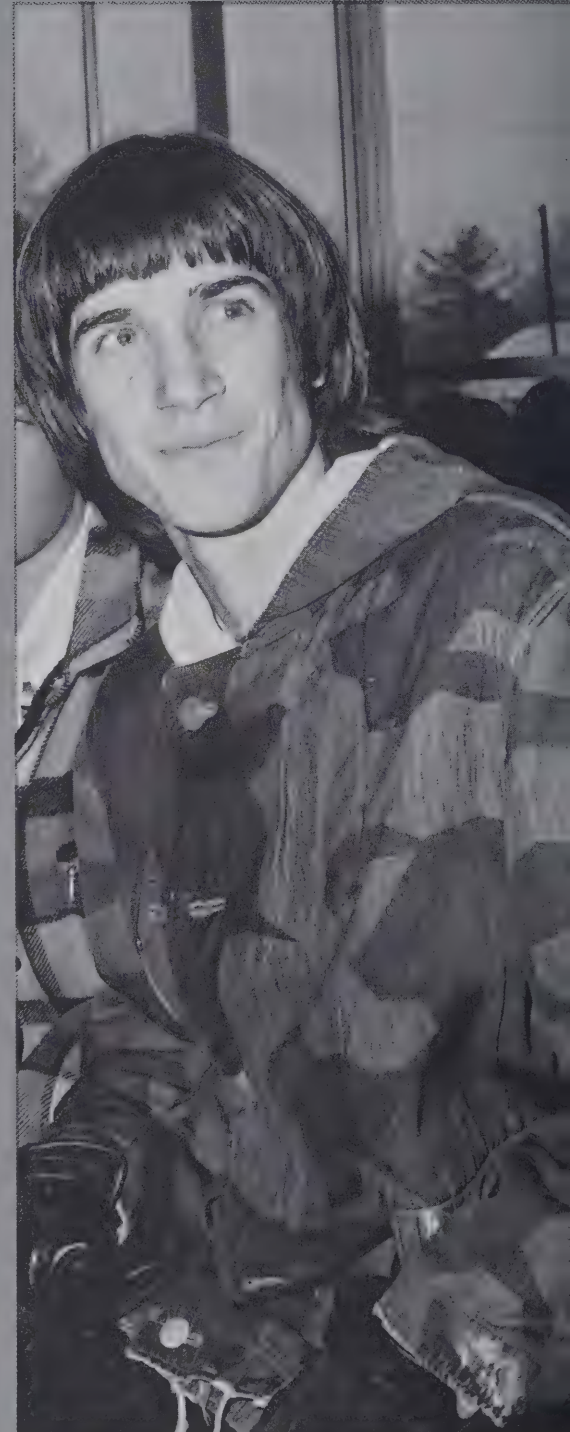
Gail Scotton's responsibilities as Student Body President are many and varied. She meets these duties with determination and a smile. Gail has served on various committees with young people in the state.

A North Carolina schoolhouse, typical of the ones in use when Union School was established in 1832

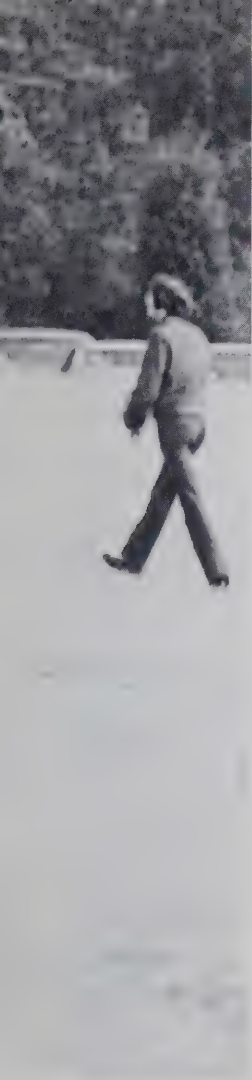
Duke University Wasn't Born Yesterday.

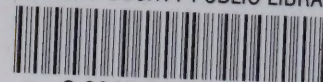
