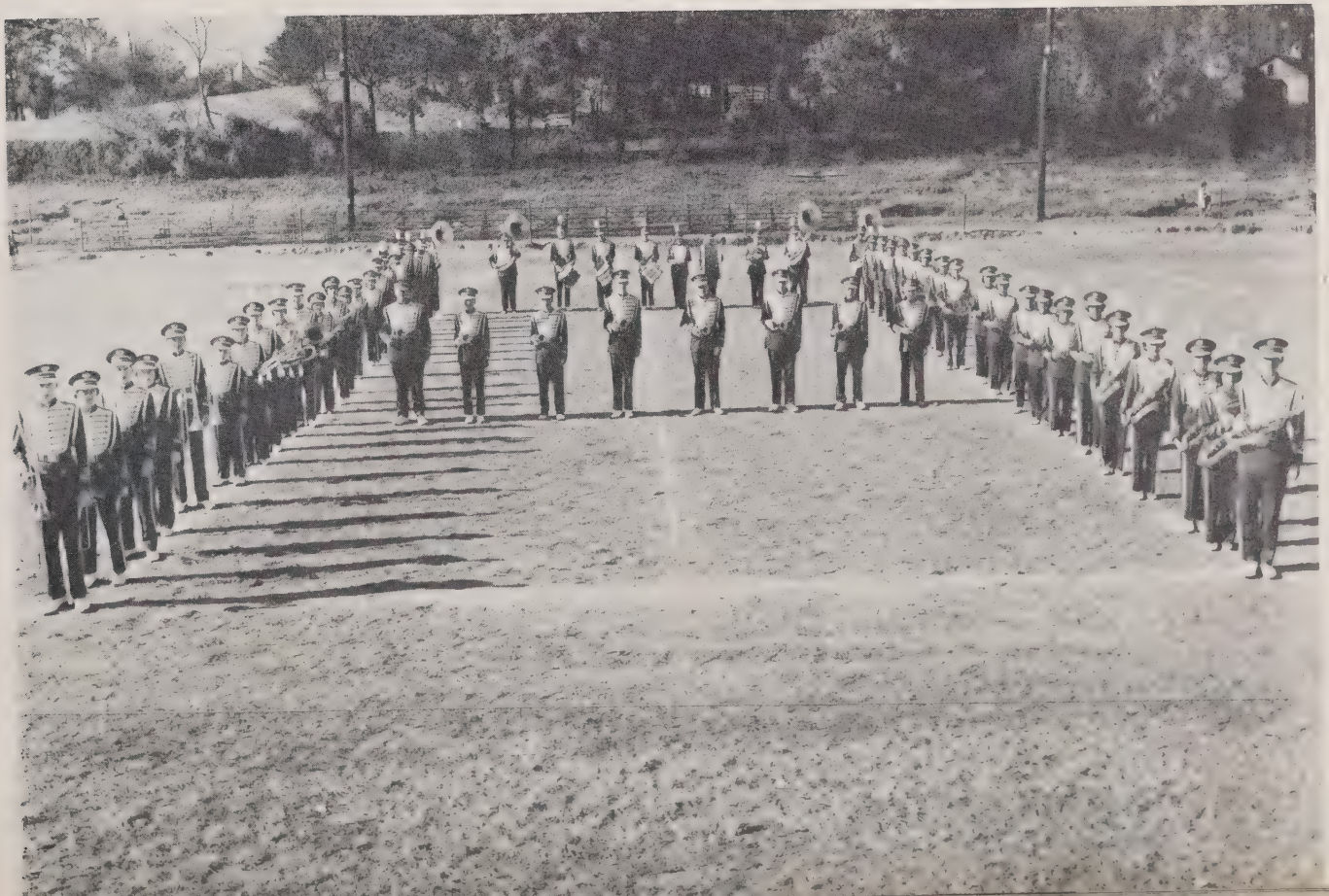
The Glen Alpine School Band, approximately seventy members strong, presented marvelous half-time performances at nine of eleven football games last fall.

The Green Wave, a perennial Skyline power with a lightning-fast secondary and a stout forward wall, continued dominance on the gridiron by battering Andrews, 21-6, for the Class "A" crown.

Under the tutoring of head coach Ralph Wilson, who is in his 14th year at Glen Alpine, and assistant coach, Lane Arrington, the Wave have won twenty-four consecutive games. During fourteen years under Wilson, Glen Alpine has compiled a record of 97-36-5.
