Neon lights flashing--laughter and screams of joy projecting--buildings of various sizes, shapes, and color protruding--all of this makes up the Glen Alpine World's Fair of 1985.

The president of this fabulous fair is Steve Watson, a native of G. A. As we begin our tour of the fair, we will encounter many people with whom we were once very familiar.

One of the most outstanding features of the fair is a gigantic turkey--symbolic of Glen Alpine itself. The designing and building of the turkey was engineered by Gerry Davis and James Patton, Dean Powell and Mickey Milligan, both "Wall Street Brokers," donated it to the Fair.
