SENIOR CLASS

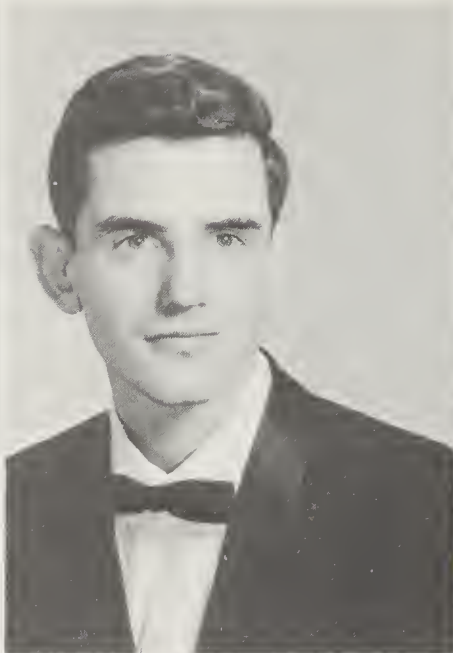

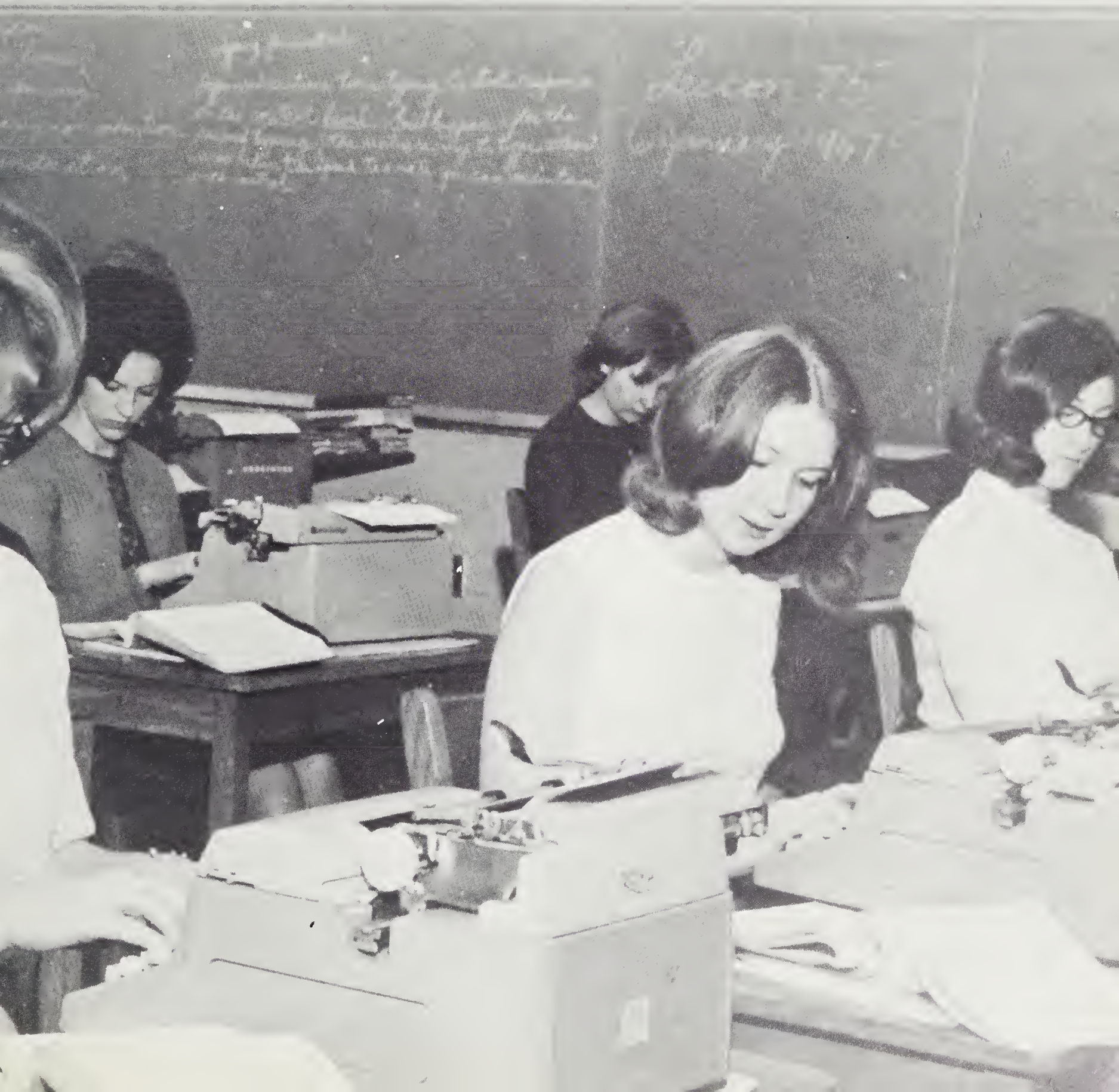
There are many awards made for outstanding achievements and contributions in special fields; some of our clubs provide such awards to participating students.

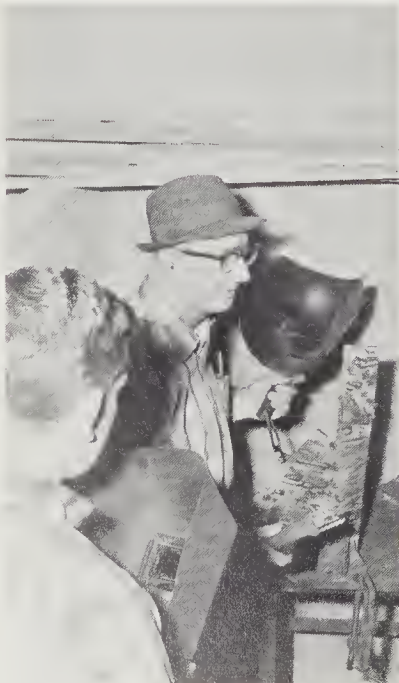


FUTURE FARMERS OF AMERICA

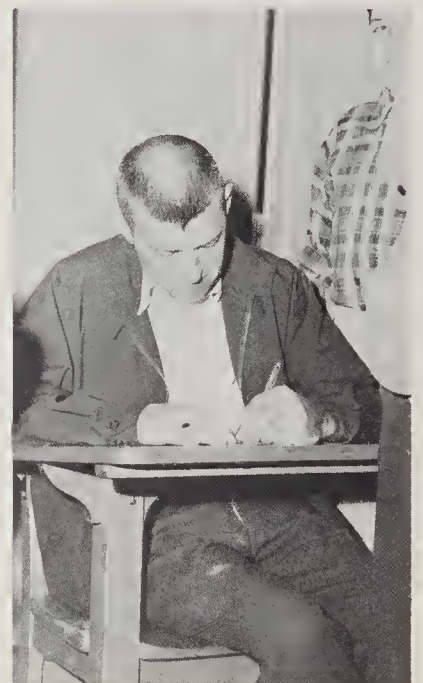

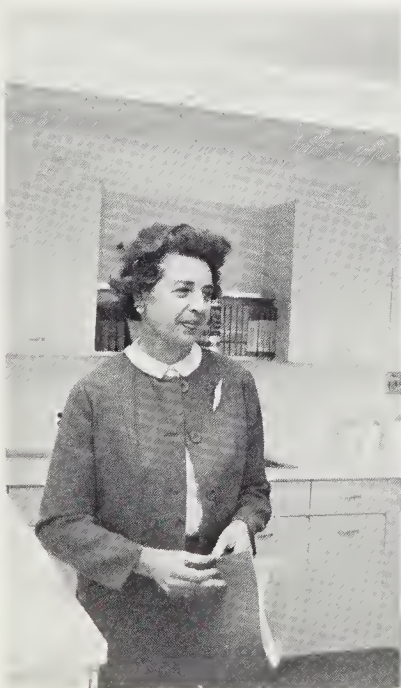


FUTURE HOMEMAKERS OF AMERICA
