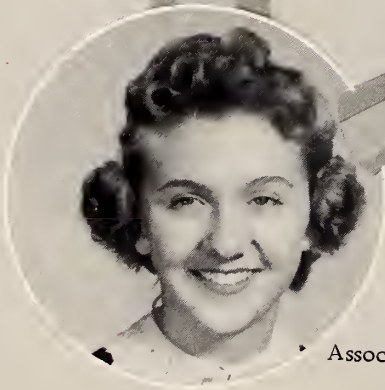

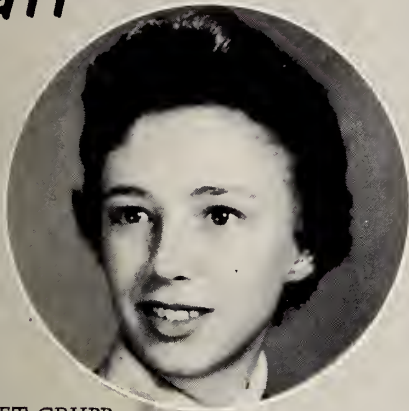
Foreword
