

3rd day
started at day break. Sgt Pascudala
shot a deer returned to camp
cleaned and eat all we could
are carrying the rest is very
foggy cannot see. am traveling
40 up a steep hog back
can get no bearings as yet
estimate elevation about 4300 ft
one hour later

still climbing still foggy cannot
see anything course 30
30 a group of *Thrasornis*
gambelii
 $\frac{1}{2}$ hr later

still climbing expect to be on
top in one hour course 15
Estimated 11-30 AM

at about 2000 ft
will take 1 hour as it is necessary
to circle to the West.

reading Malindang 3600
course about 300 x 20
got within 50 ft of the Peak
there is a narrow gorge about
30 ft wide and 400 ft deep
cannot pass without wings
Estimate altitude 8000

Malindang is about 500 ft
higher than here, have been
as far both ways as possible
to go, cannot see any possible
way to reach base of main peak,
as it is surrounded by deep narrow
chasms interesting each other
if one could reach base could
get on top easy, as to trying
to see any distance, I can
get no bearings. am compelled
to go down at least 4000 ft
to get water, we have found
nothing but a few puddles above
3500 ft. have existed an bajub
water since leaving Mame river

camped on stream about 1500 ft
above bottom of canon have plenty
of water here there is no
place to camp above 5000 ft

4 day

am having all kinds
of trouble am in deep
trouble very hard to get
out. Sgt. asked me to let
him hunt deer for 1 hr.
has been gone 4 hrs
the other soldier says
he went to a savanna
shack to buy rice and
will go on to death
