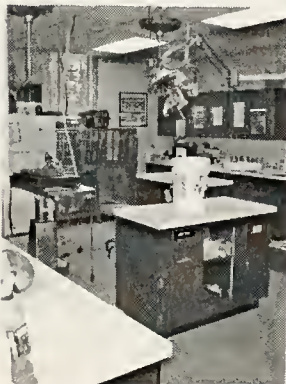
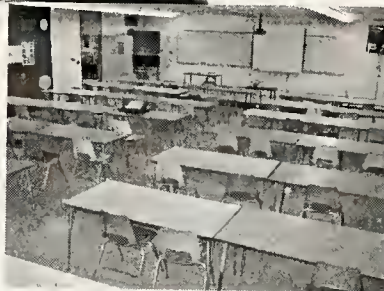
VMT Campus

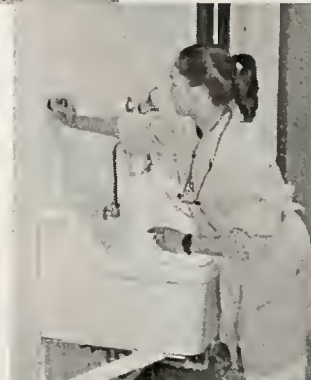

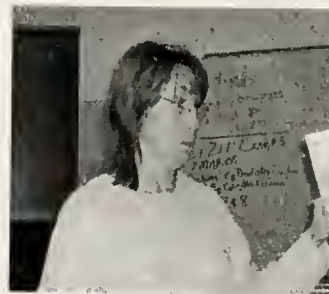

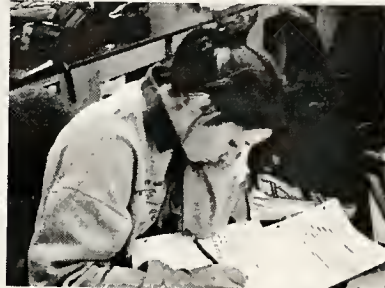

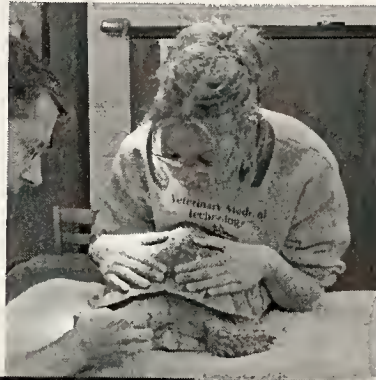
