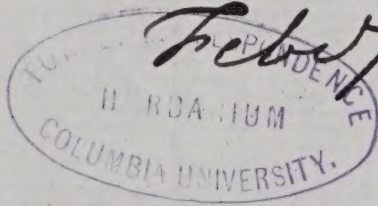

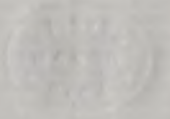


My dear Sir
