The Daybreak Sextette

THE Daybreak Sextette is composed of the old pink Daybreak and five of our own seedlings from that variety, viz., Purity, Salmon King, Lemon Drop, Rosy Morn, and Lavender Daybreak.

Daybreak

The seed of this Aster has always been scarce, but this year we have a fine stock of seed, and are prepared to fill all orders from seed grown from our own original stock. The flowers are large, and double to the center, the color is an exquisite shade of sea shell pink, resembling the color of Daybreak Carnation. The plant is a strong, compact grower, and the flowers are borne upright on long stiff stems. A field of the plants in bloom is a sight never to be forgotten, and is charming beyond description.

Purity

The White Daybreak

A pure white Aster of great beauty, which originated with us several years ago. The plant is of most symmetrical habit, usually growing about 18 inches high. The plants are literally one mass of snow white flowers of large size, resembling great balls of snow. As a cut flower variety Purity is first-class, the

stems being long and strong, and the plant is of free and branching habit. This variety is thought very highly of by all florists who have seen it growing at our seed farm.

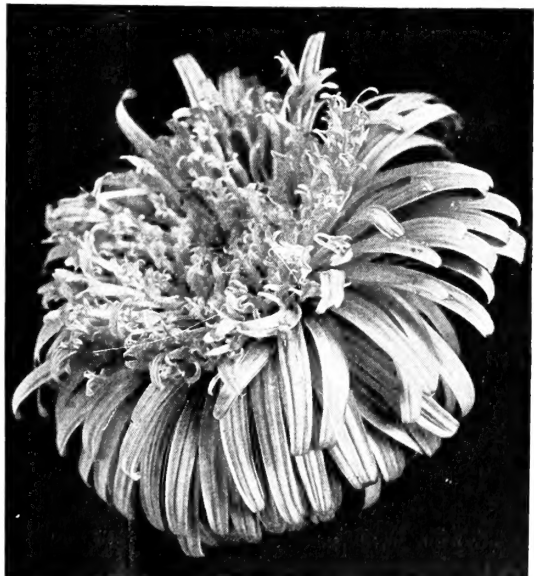

Lavender Gem

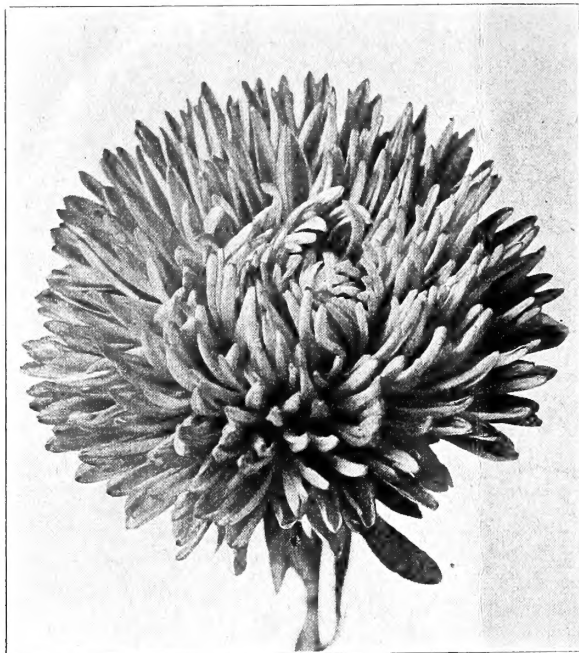
When the flower first opens it is a delicate lavender, deepening with age. The flower is always full double, showing no tendency to produce single or semi-double blooms. The feathery effect of the Ostrich feathered type, to which it belongs, is enhanced by the fact that it bears a large proportion of long, partly tubular, florets, irregularly cut and slashed, so that the flower looks like a ragged Chrysanthemum.

The plant is erect and of medium height, branching close to the ground. The flowers are borne in profusion on long, slender, wiry stems. The illustration of The Favorite shown below is a good representation of Lavender Gem, as both varieties have the same shaped and formed flowers.

Violet King

The habit is similar to the popular Vick's Branching, vigorous in growth, long stiff stems. In form the flower is entirely new and distinct from any other variety; petals somewhat resemble the quilled varieties, but are much larger and broader, those in the center being curled and incurved, completely covering the crown. In shape and size the bloom is round, full and very large, many of the flowers measuring from four to five inches. The color is a soft violet-lilac. It comes into bloom several days before Vick's Branching. (See illustration.)

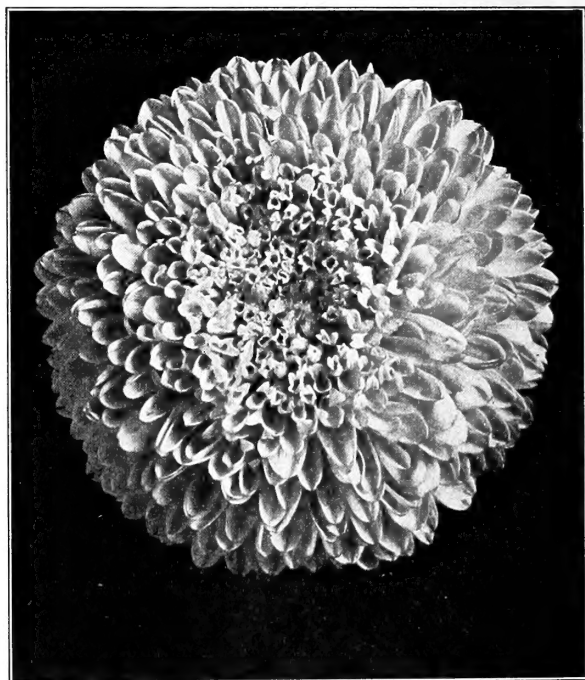

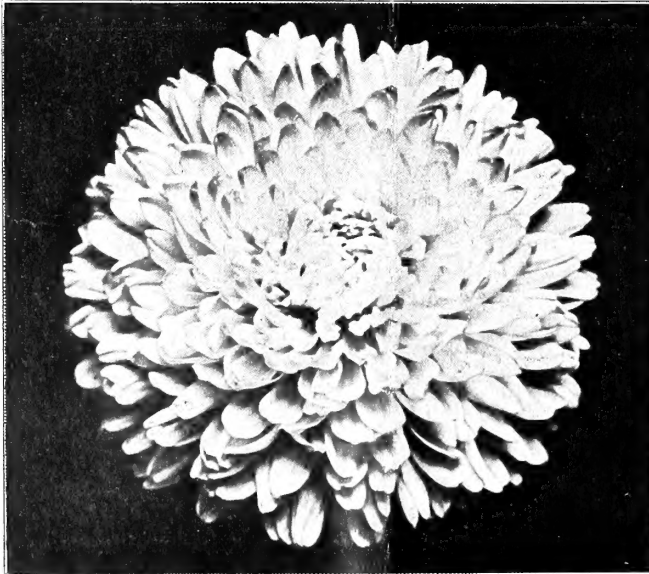
