The feathery effect of the Ostrich feathered type, to which it belongs, is enhanced by the faet that it bears a large proportion of long, partly tubular, florets, irregularly cut and slashed, so that the flower looks like a ragged Chrysanthemum.

The plant is erect and of medium height, branching close to the ground. The flowers are borne in profusion on long, slender, wiry stems.
