



Even though time will progress and leave the past far behind, the memories of our years at Owen will form a timeless memorial to some of the best years of our lives.








The two year courses in French and Latin offered at Owen not only give the student a working knowledge of the language itself, but also introduce him to the culture and customs of other countries.





Miss Hanlon and Mrs. Conger are always ready to give answers and advise to the many varied questions of students.








# FHA


Another year has passed, but its events will never be forgotten. They have been recorded in the memories of every student who has been at Owen.
