The Future Homemakers of America is a club for high school girls who are or have been enrolled in home economics. The purpose of this organization is to encourage good homemaking, leadership, and character.



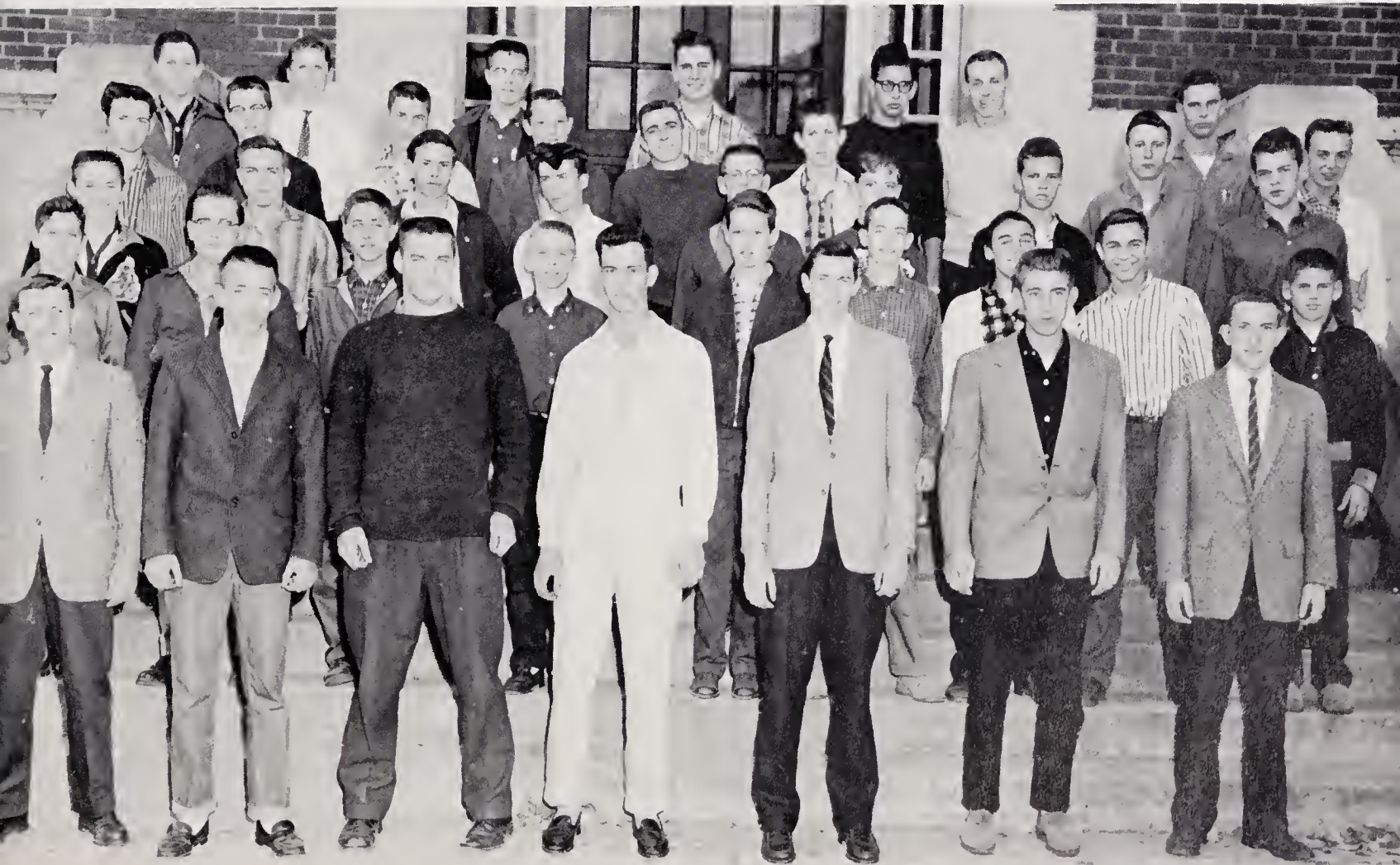
